### Rationale:

Apportionment is now required on an annual basis. The numbers used come from the Office of the Provost. Since it is the responsibility of the SEC to see that elections get carried out AND that regular apportionment takes place, it is appropriate business for the SEC to consider. Exactly how the SEC makes known to the wider community what these results are is a matter of discussion for the SEC.

#### Response:

Senate Executive Committee, Agenda Setting Meeting, 3-11-04, The SEC saw no need for senate approval of an action simply putting into effect the new apportionment method approved by the senate last year.
