Goal of Prep Clinic

Provide Truvada as HIV prophylaxis for high risk patients at minimal to no cost

Clients Sought

- -- Serodiscordant partners of HIV + patients
- -- Patients identified as high risk through our STD clinic
- -- "Word of mouth" patients in our region

Who needs PrEP?

CDC updated guidelines 2017 and FDA revision May 2018

MSM

- -Adult or adolescent man
- -HIV negative
- -Any male sex partner(s) in past 6 months
- -Not in monogamous partnership with a recently tested HIV negative man

AND at least one –

- -Any anal sex without condoms in past 6 months
- -A bacterial STI diagnosed or reported in past 6 months

HETEROSEXUAL MEN AND WOMEN

- -ADULT/ADOLESCENT PERSON
- -HIV NEGATIVE
- -ANY SEX WITH OPPOSITE SEX PARTNER(S) IN PAST 6 MONTHS
- -NOT ON MONOGAMOUS PARTNERSHIP WITH A RECENTLY TESTED HIV NEGATIVE PARTNER

AND AT LEAST ONE OF FOLLOWING-

- -MAN WHO HAS SEX WITH BOTH WOMEN AND MEN
- -INFREQUENTLY USES CONDOMS DURING SEX WITH 1 OR MORE PARTNERS OF UNKNOWN HIV STATUS WHO ARE HIGH RISK
- -IN AN ONGOING SEXUAL RELATIONSHIP WITH AN HIV POSITIVE PARTNER
- -A BACTERIAL STI DIAGNOSED OR REPORTED IN THE PAST 6 MONTHS

FOR IDU

- -ADULT/ADOLESCENT PERSON
- -HIV NEGATIVE
- -ANY INJECTION OF DRUGS NOT PRESCRIBED BY A CLINICIAN IN THE PAST 6 MONTHS

AND AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING -

- -ANY SHARING OF INJECTION OR DRUG PREPARATION EQUIPMENT IN PAST 6 MONTHS
- -RISK OF SEXUAL ACQUISITION (SEE MSM/HETEROSEXUAL CRITERIA)

PrEP Clinic Navigation

1. Client meets with nurse, HIV risk factors are assessed as outlined above. Guidelines followed for patient appropriateness for treatment.

Navigation (cont)

2. Patient education provided on: PrEP program and participant requirements, condom use, s/s of acute HIV infection and STDs, NSAID use while on Truvada, pregnancy, breastfeeding and pregnancy intentions.

Navigation (cont)

3. Baseline lab testing: BMP with eGFR, Rapid HIV, RPR, Hepatitis panel, urine GC/Chlamydia (3 point testing if MSM), UPT if applicable. Cost less than \$20

4. Client then meets with benefit counselor to assess insurance status and possible need for copay assistance or prescription assistance programs.

Initiation

Once labs return, MD reviews patient health history, medications and lab results.

RX written for Truvada if appropriate.

Initiation (continued)

Nurse meets with patient, Truvada education provided and counseled on medication adherence. Truvada Rx sent to pharmacy.

Follow-up Visits

Patient scheduled for quarterly visits, and instructed to call for any questions, medication side effects or STD symptoms.

Monthly or more frequent calls from pharmacist.

Follow Up Visits (continued)

With each quarterly visit, patient meets with nurse, education provided on condom use, risk behaviors, s/s of STD or acute HIV infection, and condoms are provided.

FOLLOW UP LABS

Rapid HIV test (STI screening if appropriate)

Full STD screening, BMP and eGFR, and Rapid HIV.

Rapid HIV test (STI screening if appropriate)

Full STD screening, BMP and eGFR, and Rapid HIV

Refills

New Rx written by MD every three months after patient visit

Costs to patient

Semiannual STD labs BMP with eGFR

Total less than \$60/year, including baseline testing

Results

Timeframe

3/15/16 to present

13 patients sought PrEP services

7 patients started Truvada (4 had insurance)

6 patients did not meet PrEP criteria

1 patient stopped Truvada due to side effect (fatigue)

2 patients lost to follow up or were noncompliant

PrEP continues

4 patients

Only one of PrEP patients on Truvada was a partner of a HIV + patient

No longer on PrEP
