## **CONFERRING OF THE MEDALLION AWARD**

The Medallion Award is conferred by Villanova University in recognition of the outstanding achievements of the recipient.

### **HAROLD HONGJU KOH, A.B., B.A., M.A., J.D.**

The Honorable Harold Hongju Koh was sworn in as United States Assistant Secretary of State for Democracy, Human Rights and Labor on November 13, 1998. In that role, he advises Secretary of State Madeline Albright on foreign policy pertaining to democracy, human rights, labor, the rule of law and religious freedom.

Assistant Secretary Koh brings a distinguished background to his position. He holds the Gerard C. and Bernice Latrobe Smith Professorship in International Law at Yale Law School. Before taking a leave from Yale to join the Department of State, he also directed Yale's Orville H. Schell, Jr. Center for International Human Rights and taught a broad range of courses. He has written more than 70 articles on international law, human rights, constitutional law, and international business transactions and trade. He has also written and edited several books in these areas. His teaching and his own volunteer work have served as an inspiration to his students, many of whom followed his example in providing pro bono legal services to under-represented, indigent people caught in the vortex of the legal system. His work has also earned him numerous honors including the Asian American Bar Association of New York's 1997 Outstanding Lawyer of the Year Award, and recognition by *American Lawyer* magazine as one of the country's 45 leading public sector lawyers under the age of 45.

Before he joined the Yale Law faculty, Assistant Secretary Koh clerked for Justice Harry A. Blackmun of the United States Supreme Court, and for Judge Malcolm Richard Wilkey on the United States Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit. He also worked as an associate at Covington & Burling in Washington, D.C., as an attorney-adviser in the office of Legal Counsel at the United States Department of Justice, and taught at the George Washington University National Law Center.

Assistant Secretary Koh earned his J.D. from Harvard Law School in 1980, where he was Developments Editor of the *Harvard Law Review*, a B.A. from Harvard University in 1975, an Honours B.A. from Oxford University in 1977, and a Masters from Oxford in 1996. He taught as a visiting fellow and lecturer at Oxford University, and has also taught at the Hague Academy of International Law, the University of Toronto, and the George Washington University National Law Center.

## THE ORDER OF THE COIF

The Order of the Coif is the National Honor Society devoted to the encouragement of high standards of legal scholarship with chapters in leading law schools throughout the country. Graduates in the top ten percent of the class are eligible for election to the Order of the Coif.

The Order takes its name from the word used to designate the cap which all the members of the Order were required to wear. This cap or coif was originally of white lawn or silk, forming a close-fitting hood, seen today in old engravings, pictures and effigies of distinguished Judges and Serjeants. Serjeants were an order of the highest rank of barrister at the English or Irish bar. By the ancient privileges of the Serjeants, this coif was not to be taken off, even in the royal presence. When wigs came into fashion the coif was changed, no longer worn as a complete hood, but merely as a circular piece of white lawn fastened to the top of the wig.
