Martin G. McGuinn is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Mellon Financial Corporation, a global financial services company headquartered in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Mellon is one of the world's leading providers of financial services for institutions, corporations and high net worth individuals, providing institutional asset management, mutual funds, private wealth management, asset servicing, human resource services and treasury services. Its asset management companies include The Dreyfus Corporation and U.K.-based Newton Investment Management Limited. Mr. McGuinn became Chairman and CEO of the Corporation on January 1, 1999, and has been Chairman and CEO of Mellon Bank, N.A. since March 1, 1998. He is a Director of the Corporation and Mellon Bank. From 1990 to 1998, Mr. McGuinn was Vice Chairman of the Corporation and of Mellon Bank. Mr. McGuinn joined Mellon in 1981.

A Philadelphia native, Mr. McGuinn received a bachelor's degree and a juris doctor degree, both from Villanova University. He then served for three years in the U.S. Marine Corps as a captain, including a tour in Vietnam.

Mr. McGuinn is very active with a number of community and industry organizations. In September 2002, he was appointed by President Bush to the National Infrastructure Advisory Council, which will make recommendations to the President regarding the security of the country's cyber and information systems and other economically critical infrastructures. He has been named Chairman and is a Director of the Financial Services Roundtable and serves as a Director of the American Bankers Association and Shinsei Bank (Japan). He is a member of the Federal Reserve Board's Federal Advisory Council.

Mr. McGuinn also serves on several boards, including Carnegie Mellon University, the Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh, the Historical Society of Western Pennsylvania, University of Pittsburgh Medical Center and the Eisenhower Exchange Fellowships, and is Chairman of the Allegheny Conference on Community Development.

ORDER OF THE COIF

The Order of the Coif is the National Honor Society devoted to the encouragement of high standards of legal scholarship with chapters in leading law schools throughout the country. Graduates in the top ten percent of the class are eligible for election to the Order of the Coif.

The Order takes its name from the word used to designate the cap which all members of the Order were required to wear. This cap or coif was originally of white lawn or silk, forming a close-fitting hood, seen today in old engravings, pictures and effigies of distinguished Judges and Serjeants. Serjeants were an order of the highest rank of barrister at the English or Irish bar. By the ancient priveleges of the Serjeants, this coif was not to be taken off, even in the royal presence. When wigs came into fashion the coif was changed, no longer worn as a complete hood, but merely as a circular piece of white lawn fastened to the top of the wig.
