I Sarch Cuminglam of heweette in the County of and State of Maine, aged Lists seven years, do, upon oath, declare, in order to obtain the benefit of a Resolve of the Legislature of Maine, passed March 17, 1835, entitled a "Resolve in favor of certain Officers and Soldiers of the Revolutionary War, and the Widows of the deceased Officers and Soldiers," that I am the widow of Samuel burninglem newcestle in the County of Lineoh and State of Maine, who died at menswich in said State on the. day of September That I have reason to believe, and do fully believe, that my said late husband, Samuel Cemmentem did enlist as a prevate soldier in the War of the Revolution in the 1777, for three years on the continental establishment - that he enlisted into loophein m. allesters bompany but sewel the principal part if nor all the time in Coptain Woodbridges Company, Colonel Wiggles worth, Marsacheretts Re-giment - that he seemed the their years fully our oreceived an homourche discharge which to lost - and that the reason of his discharge was that the time of his sail service of three years had felly expired and ended. I do further on oath declare that I have reason to believe, and do fully believe, that my said late husband, Samuel Cuming Lem was at the time of his said enlistment, an inhabitant of Sefferson in the County of Ericoln State of Maine and that I do know that he was at the time of his decease as aforesaid, an inhabitant of the said State of Maine, residing in Buenswich aforesaid, where he had resided for only a forthigh weare before his decease. That I have reason to believe, and do fully believe, that neither my said late husband, nor any one claiming under him did receive, (nor have I received since his decease,) a grant of Land, or money in lieu thereof, from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, for his said service, or any other service during the Revolutionary War, and that I am therefore justly entitled to the full benefit of said Resolve.
