I Abigail Davis of Ellsworth in County of Hancock and State of Maine aged about 80 years do upon oath declare in order to obtain the benefit of a resolve of the Legislature of Maine passed March 17 1835 entitled a resolve in favour of certain Officers and soldiers of the Revolutionary war and the widows of the said Officers and soldiers that I am the widow of Ezra Davis late of Kitzfort in the County of Hancock and State of Maine who died at Kitzfort a host this 21st day of Sept^r A. D. 1823 that I have reason to believe and do fully believe that my said late husband Ezra Davis did enlist as a private for three years in the year 1780 or 81 in the 1st Regt^t of the Continental Army and having served a honorable Discharge and was on the Pension Roll of the United States at the time of his Death I do further on oath declare that I have reason to believe and do fully believe that my said late husband Ezra Davis was at the time of his enlistment an inhabitant of the State of Maine and that I do know that he was at the time of his Death as above said an inhabitant of the State of Maine residing in Kitzfort a fore said where he had resided for several years he bore his Discharge that I have reason to believe and do fully believe that neither my said late husband nor any one claiming under him did receive nor have I received since his Death a grant of Land or money in lieu thereof from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for his said services nor and that I am therefore fully entitled to the full benefit of said resolve
