I Simeon Grandison of Tutuata in the County of Plymouth do upon oath testify and declare that I enlisted into the service of the United States for the term of three years or "during the War." and that he served in No. 1. of the Massachusetts line Commanded by Col. Seth Warner, and that he continued in the service aforesaid until the close of the war, when he was regularly discharged by from said Regiment by Col. Warner, but which discharge was lost or destroyed many years since.

I further declare that I enlisted in a Town or Place then called Otis in the Western part of Mass. in Capt. Wait Hopkins's Company of Infantry, and were attached to Gen. L. Wayne's Brigade, & General Patterson's Division. I further declare that I never received a patent or title for the quantity of Bounty Land promised to me, on the part of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Therefore I know all men by these presents, that I Simeon Grandison aforesaid do hereby constitute and appoint Charles Turner of Chelsea in the County of Suffolk, for me and in my name, to demand and receive from the Com. of Mass. a Patent or title for the quantity of Bounty Land due me from said Com. of Mass. or the money offered in lieu thereof, at his option.
