I. Joshua Swan do declare that I
belong to Methuen in the County of
Essex & have always been an inhabitant
of this Commonwealth. That in the year
1777. I enlisted ^{at Andover} in a company of artificers
which company at the time of my enlist-
ment was commanded by Capt Pollard after-
wards by Capt Parker. The Regiment to
which the said company was attached was
under the command of Colonel Baldwin
at the time of my enlistment, I resided in
Andover, where I was an apprentice, though
Methuen was my native place.
