On this tenth day of June A.D. 1835 personally before Nathl. M. Loring a Justice of the Peace for said county Cole. Andrew Tyler of Frankfort in said county who being first duly sworn, answering to and doth on his oath make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by a Resolve of the State of Maine (Approved March 17. 1835) That he enlisted in the Army of the United States about the first of January 1776 for one year & served that time in Capt. Abner Tyler's Company Colonel Colonel Thimney's Regiment of the Massachusetts line. Afterward & about the first of January 1777 he again enlisted into the Army of the United States for three years & served that length of time in Captain Silas Burbanks Company, Colonel Samuel Brewster's Regiment of the Massachusetts line & immediately after the expiration of the last mentioned term of service expired, he again volunteered & served two months more in Capt. James Meares Company Colonel Sprouts Regiment - He received a discharge which was dated some time in March 1780, this was the only written discharge he ever had - This discharge together with a Sergeants Warrant which he held in the Army have been sent to the War Department at Washington At the times of each of his said several enlistments he resided & had his home in Scarborough, Massachusetts He now resides & on the 17th day of March 1835 he resided in Frankfort in said county of Waldo - The reason of his being discharged from said several enlistments was that his term of service according to the enlistment had expired -

That neither he nor any other person claiming under him has ever received a grant of land or money from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts & that he is justly entitled to a grant of land under the provisions of said Resolve

of Frankfort in the county of Waldo & State of Maine being
the same Person by whom the preceding declaration was
made do hereby constitute & appoint Nathaniel M. Lowrey
my true & lawful Attorney for me & in my name to receive
from the Land Agent of the State of Maine such certificate
as he may issue to me in virtue of a Resolve of said State
passed March 17. 1835 entitled a "Resolve in favor of certain
Officers & Soldiers of the Revolutionary War & the widows
of deceased ^{officers &} Soldiers" to the benefit of which Resolve I am
entitled. And my said Attorney is hereby authorized
& empowered upon the receipt of said certificate for
me in my name, to execute such receipt & acknowledge
same thence, as I might were I personally present.
Hereby ratifying & confirming whatever my Attorney shall
do by virtue hereof. Witness my hand & seal this tenth
day of June 1835.
