all my right, title & interest in & unto the land
to which I am entitled by virtue of a Resolve of the
Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
granting land to the noncommissioned officers &
privates of the Massachusetts quota of the army of
the Revolutionary War. And hereby request the
Said agent of said Commonwealth to execute
a deed accordingly.

Dated at Augusta, Maine, this 31st day of January
A. D. 1832.
