Know all Men by these Presents, THAT

Whose name is undersigned & seal hereunto affixed,
appointed an AGENT by the General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to make
and execute conveyances, agreeably to resolves of said Court passed *the 17th day of*
June 1820 _____ and pursuant to
resolves of said Court passed *the 4th day of March 1828, 15th day*
of February 1829, and 18th day February
1831 _____

do give, grant, convey and confirm, and by these presents, in behalf of said Commonwealth,
have given, granted, conveyed and confirmed unto *the heirs of Hugh Paul,*
formerly a private soldier in the second
Massachusetts regiment commanded by
Col. Bailey. _____

who enlisted as a Soldier into the American Army to serve during the revolutionary War
with Great Britain, and who was returned as a part of the Massachusetts quota of said
Army, and who did actually serve in said Army the full term of three years, and was hon-
orably discharged, and to his heirs and assigns, all the right, title, and interest of said
Commonwealth, in and unto a lot of land numbered *102* _____

situate and lying in a township, in the County
of *Penobscot* -- in the State of Maine, *Numbered two in the*
7th range of townships, west of the east line
of said State. _____

said lot contains two hundred acres, bounded *On the north by lot number*
103, on the east by lot number
90, on the south by lot number 101, and on the
west by number 104. _____

according to a plan of the survey of said township made by *Joseph L. Kelsey* in
the Autumn of _____ *eighteen hundred and twenty*
nine and will more fully appear on reference being had to said plan now on file in
the Land Office.

To Have and to Hold the aforegranted premises to the *heirs of said*
Hugh Paul -- *their* heirs and assigns, to their use

When he was regularly discharged from the said
Regiment of the Massachusetts line commanded
By Colonel Sprout and further declare that
the said Hugh Paul died at Wessensburg
in the State of New York in the year 1882
and that I have seen his discharge.

Therefore know all men By these presents that
I Hatharine Shipper aforesaid do hereby consti-
tute and appoint Lewis Wakeley of the City
of Albany to be my true and lawful attorney
for me and in my name to select from the
tract of land appropriated By the Commonweal-
th of Massachusetts for the satisfaction of Revolu-
tionary Claims such lot or lots of land
as he shall see fit and proper and further
to receive from the Land agent of the ^{said} Comm-
onwealth a title or deed therefor in testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my name and seal
