Know all men by these presents That I
Archibald Todd of Mansfield in the County
of Bristol and Commonwealth of Massachusetts
Yeoman have appointed and do by these presents
Name and appoint Nath Claplin of Middle-
borough in Said County of Bristol Esquire
To be my true and lawful attorney for
me and in my name and to my use to ask
for and receive of the Land agent for
the State of Massachusetts all such allowance
of Land or Money as I am entitled to
on account of my Serving a three years
tween in the army of the Revolution -
and I have by authority here my Said
agent to sign any and all such receipt
or discharge to the Said agent or agents
hereby authorizing and confirming all
and whatsoever he my Said agent shall
or may be required to do in the premises
as fully as I could do my self if I were
personally present -

discharge given him at the expiration of his term of 3
years service in the war of the Revolution (made in his
his passion) of which I thereby certify the above is a true
Copy

Now C. C. Cliflin Justice of the Peace
I further certify that I have been personally
acquainted with the above named Archibald
Todd ever since he returned from the army
about the close of the Revolutionary war
that he has been an Inhabitant in Foxborough
for a part of the first years after his return and
for more than forty years past he has been an
Inhabitant of Mansfield
