**Know all Men by these Presents, THAT**

I whose name is undersigned do seal hereunto affix  
appointed an AGENT by the General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to make  
and execute conveyances, agreeably to a resolve of said Court passed the seventeenth  
day of June eighteen hundred and twenty  
and pursuant to  
resolves of said Court passed the fourth day of March eighteen  
hundred and twenty eight, eighteenth day of  
February eighteen hundred and twenty nine  
and eighteenth day of February eighteen hundred  
and thirty one

do give, grant, convey and confirm, and by these presents, in behalf of said Commonwealth,  
have given, granted, conveyed and confirmed unto Nathaniel Hollings,  
formerly a private Soldier in the thirteenth  
Massachusetts regiment commanded by  
Col Smith.

who enlisted as a Soldier into the American Army to serve during the revolutionary War  
with Great Britain, and who was returned as a part of the Massachusetts quota of said  
Army, and who did actually serve in said Army the full term of three years, and was honorably discharged, and to his heirs and assigns, all the right, title, and interest of said  
Commonwealth, in and unto a lot of land numbered Eight and Nine in the  
twelfth range of lots - situate and lying in a township, in the County  
of Somerset - in the State of Maine, Numbered four of the  
second range of townships, North of Bingham's  
Rimmon Purchase -

said lot contains two hundred acres, bounded on the north by lot number  
eight & nine of the thirteenth range, on the east by  
lot number ten of the twelfth range, on the south by  
lot number eight and nine of the eleventh range, and  
on the west by lot number seven of the twelfth range -  
according to a plan of the survey of said township made by Ezra Elam  
in the month of October of eighteen hundred and eighteen  
and will more fully appear on reference being had to said plan now on file in  
the Land Office.

**To Have and to Hold** the aforesigned premises to the said

Nathaniel Hollings Jacob Decker his heirs and assigns, to his and their use  
and behoof forever. IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand, and affixed my  
seal this Seventh day of July in the year of our Lord eighteen  
hundred and thirty two.

do upon oath Testify and declare That I enlisted in the year 1777  
into the Army of the American Revolution in the service of the State of Massa-  
chusetts for the term of (During the war) and that I served in the 13th,  
9th, and 6th Regiments and also was drafted into Gen. Washington's  
Dragoon Guards and was honorably Discharged at the close of the war  
from the 3d Massachusetts Regiment commanded by Colonel Graton  
I further declare that my original Discharge signed by Gen. George Washington  
is now in my possession I further declare that I have never received  
a Certificate for the Quantity of Land Promised to me on the part of  
the State of Massachusetts for the aforesaid Services nor any commu-  
tation therefor In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this 3<sup>d</sup> day of May 1832

port County of Cayuga and State of New York late a soldier of the Army of the  
American Revolution as set forth in the above declaration for and in con-  
sideration of the sum of Forty Dollars to me in hand paid the Receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and Transferred to  
Jacob Decker of the Town of Seneca Falls Seneca County and state aforesaid  
All my right Title interest claims and demands for in and to the  
aforesaid Military Bounty Land Claim I have and to Hold the  
aforesaid bargained Premises to the said Jacob Decker his Executors  
Administrators Heirs and Assigns forever And I the said  
Nathaniel Williams for myself my heirs and Executors shall and  
will warrant and defend the same against all persons unto the said  
Jacob Decker his Heirs Executors and Assigns by these presents  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this  
third day of May 1832
