Know all Men by these Presents, THAT
I whose name is undersigned I seal hereunto affixed
appointed an AGENT by the General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, to make
and execute conveyances, agreeably to resolves of said Court passed the 17th day
of June 1820 —

and pursuant to
resolves of said Court passed the fourth day of March 1828, 10.th day
of February 1829, and 10.th day of February 1831

to give, grant, convey and confirm, and by these presents, in behalf of said Commonwealth,
have given, granted, conveyed and confirmed unto Jedediah Winchell, formerly
a private soldier in the thirteenth Massachusetts
regiment commanded by Colonel Smith

who enlisted as a Soldier into the American Army to serve during the revolutionary War
with Great Britain, and who was returned as a part of the Massachusetts quota of said
Army, and who did actually serve in said Army the full term of three years, and was honorably
discharged, and to his heirs and assigns, all the right, title, and interest of said
Commonwealth, in and unto a lot of land numbered Fifty two

situate and lying in a township, in the County
of Penobscot in the State of Maine, numbered two in the
seventh range of townships, west of the east line of
said State —

said lot contains two hundred acres, bounded on the north by lot number
fifty three, on the east by lot number forty, on the
south by lot number fifty one, and on the west
by lot number sixty four —
according to a plan of the survey of said township made by Joseph L. Kelcey
in the autumn of the year eighteen hundred and twenty
nine and will more fully appear on reference being had to said plan now on file in
the Land Office.

To Have and to Hold the aforesigned premises to the said
Jedediah Winchell — his heirs and assigns, to their use
and behoof forever. In TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand, and affixed my
seal this first day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen
hundred and thirty three

discharged from the Regiment in said Line commanded
by Colonel Tupper I further declare that I have
never received a warrant for the quantity of land
promised to me on the part of the Commonwealth of
Mass^{ts} or any commutation therefor

Therefore

Know all men by these presents that I
Feddeah Whineb appear do hereby constitute and
appoint Lewis Walkley of the City of Albany
to be my true and lawful Attorney for me and in
my name to select from the tract of ^{Land appropriated} land
by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for the
satisfaction of Revolutionary Claims such lot
or lots of land as shall appear unto my said
Attorney fit and proper and further in my
name to receive from the Land Agent of said
Commonwealth a title or Deed therefor In testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
