**MUSTER ROLL** of Captain *John P. Barnard* Company of *Infantry* in the Detachment of drafted Militia of Maine, called into Actual Service by the State, for the protection of its Northeastern Frontier, from the *first* day of *March* 1839, the time of its rendezvous at *Augusta* Maine, to the *twenty eighth* day of *March* 1839, when discharged or mustered.
