 good health & has re-enlisted  
 in Me. 19<sup>th</sup> Regt.

C. C. Braun, discharged

July 19, 1862 at Harisons  
 Landing because of "dis-  
 ability," from Co. E. Me 4th  
 by "C. Walker Col."

His residence New Castle  
 present condition lame,  
 Ephraim L. Jones Co.  
 E. 4th Me. residence  
 Danais cotta Mills -  
 discharged Sept. 26, 1861  
 "because of disability" by  
 "H. G. Berry Col."

He complains of kidney  
 disease and by enquiries  
 of physicians & others  
 I learn that he is not  
 a healthy man.

 Castle discharged  
 at Alex. Va Sept 26, 1861

 Artemas Robinson

 prisoner of war, he  
 reported in person June  
 30, 1862 at Augusta & sub-  
 sistance "examined  
 by Reuben Sawyer A.A.  
 C.S." health good.

Frederic H. Stetson Co. E.  
 Me 4th residence Dan-  
 aiscotta paroled  
 prisoner of war, discha-  
 rged by the War Depart-  
 ment.
