STATE OF MAINE
The Adjutant General's Office
Augusta, March 23, 1917

Inclosed find transportation request from your home station to Portland and return, also transportation from Portland to New York and return with pullman reservation one way, to enable you to attend the National Guard meetings in New York, March 27th, 28th and 29th.

Pullman reservation for return trip will be made by the Senior officer, Major James L. Moriarty. Hotel accommodations have been made at the Vanderbilt.

Subsistence and quarters and incidental expenses will be paid by Major Moriarty.

Officers will report to the senior officer, Major Moriarty, at Portland, Maine, March 26th, not later than 8:15 p.m., so as to embark for New York on the State of Maine express.
