Adj. Gen. John L. Hodgdon
Sir.

I received blanks
for Ord. Sergeant Bills for Services in regard to nine
months men &c. Also the number of names (42)
on the Sup. roll for which the orderly sergeant was
entitled to receive compensation. I think the bills which
I left with you are correct, from the fact that

considerable trouble and expense, after the roll
was returned to your office, to wit.
