LEADER:

The great head of the Church gave gifts to all people that some should be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, for the equipment of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature personhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.

PEOPLE:

We are the church — all kinds and conditions of people, but one body of Christ and individually members one of another.

LEADER:

There are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; there are varieties of working, but it is the same God who inspires them all in every one. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, between slave and free; between male and female; the same Lord is Lord of all and bestows his riches upon all who call upon him. So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes by the preaching of Christ.

LEADER:

In the presence of God we have met here, to acknowledge your call to service in the Church of Christ; to honor you for your perseverance, faithfulness, and diligence in study; and to present again to the Church all of you who aspire to serve the Church in a variety of ministries. The Jesus who said, "I have come not to be served, but to serve," has defined the meaning of ministry. Your schools send you forth into this ministry with their love and blessing, and pray that you may be adequate to your task.
