I have to day found Mr Samuel S. Brown who enlisted in the 10<sup>th</sup> Maine Regt vols on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October 1861 under Capt. Moses M. Robinson Was Discharged on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April 1862 at Ship Island by reason of Ritney Complaint - Discharge was approved by Maj Gen Butler - He has sent his Discharge to Boston to get his bounty and I herewith send you a copy of Receipt for his Discharge -
