To all whom it may concern

Know ye, That Dudley Chase a private of Capt. N. J. Bucknans Co, N. 5th Regiment of Maine Vols who was Enrolled on the 24th day of June 1861 to serve three years is hereby discharged from the service of the U. S. this first day of October 1861 at Camp Lyon Va by reason of Any Pectoris -

No objection to his being reenlisted is known to exist Said Dudley Chase was born in Waterboro in the State of Maine is 38 years of age 5 feet 7 inches high Sandy complexion blue eyes light hair and by occupation when Enrolled a Laborer
