

NEWS IN BRIEF.

SENATE.

The bill establishing a retired list for commissioned officers was resumed, the pending question being on Mr. Allison's amendment to appoint two colored cadets at large to West Point.

The morning hour was occupied by a discussion of Mr. Allison's amendment. Mr. Barnhill favored the amendment.

Mr. Harris would not vote to send any more cadets to the institution and every word the student he should not associate with colored cadets because of the injuries to him, and whose president issued a circular operating the cadets while they were yet on the ground.

During debate the morning hour expired and the naval appropriation bill was taken up. Mr. Daves presented the memorial of Long, Sidney Bartlett, E. R. How and a large number of leading lawyers of Massachusetts, asking for an appropriation to place the figure on a monument being erected by various States at Plymouth, Mass.

Mr. Eaton (Dem) reported favorably on the House bill resolution appropriating \$10,000 for the contingent fund of the Senate.

No amendment being offered this bill passed. Mr. Edmunds introduced a bill for the Secretary of the Senate to report upon the disposition of the contingent fund of the Senate since June 30, 1875.

The Kellogg-Spofford resolutions were taken up and supported by Mr. Allison. A speech was not concluded when the Senate adjourned on account of the funeral of Mr. Middleton, clerk of the Senate Court.
