Waterman be seated as the duly elected Representative to the Legislature of Auburn.

The Committee on Elections, to which was referred the returns of the votes cast for Representatives to the Legislature, have had the same under consideration and beg leave to report that;

According to the official canvas of the contest for Representative to the Legislature from the city of Portland John R. Hanscomb received 14,125 votes and Ronald L. Kellam received 13,993 votes.

A re-count of said ballots held on January 16, 1961 and January 17, 1961, indicated that John R. Hanscomb received 14,092 votes and Ronald L. Kellam received 14,177 votes.

Mr. Hanscomb having indicated his intention to withdraw from the contest, and the parties having agreed upon the figures recorded at the re-count, the Committee recommends, therefore, that Ronald L. Kellam be seated as the duly elected Representative to the Legislature from the city of Portland.
