#### GAY CIVIL RIGHTS BILL

Things are happening very quickly with LD 430 "An Act To Prevent Discrimination". By the time you get this copy of the newsletter the fate of the bill may already be decided, but it's possible that it may still be caught up in the legislative process. LD 430, if enacted, would protect the rights of gays and lesbians in the areas of employment, housing, public accommodations and credit. As of this writing, the bill passed by a slim margin in the state senate, then was sent on to the house of representaives where it was defeated. It must now go back to the senate for another vote. If you haven't contacted your congress people asking them to support the bill, it is vital that they hear from you.

#### Charlie Howard Weekend

A small group of GLCN members are beginning to make plans for this year's celebration of the life of Charlie Howard. This is an important anniversary to our community; a time to show Bangor, Maine that not only do we exist here, but that we laugh, we love, we make music, and we're proud of who we are.
