→ SENIORS TAKE NOTICE ←

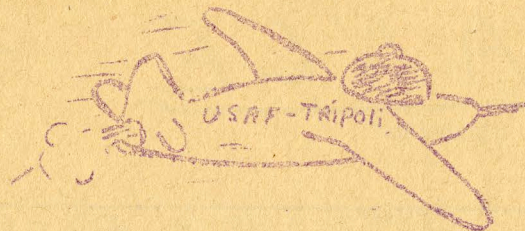
