

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 6th day of September, 19 63 by and between St. John's University, New York, party of the first part, and Madeleine D. Ciguere party of the second part:

WITNESSETH: The party of the first part agrees to employ and the party of the second part agrees to devote full time as a teacher on the staff of St. John's University for the academic year of 1963-64 and to conduct such classes, extracurricular activities and administrative work as shall be assigned to him by the President and / or Dean of the college or school in which he is assigned to teach and to render such services in a scholarly and efficient manner to the satisfaction of said officers, for the sum of \$6500.00 which amount the said party of the first part agrees to pay the said party of the second part in consideration for his services as follows: ten (10) equal monthly payments, the first of which is to be made on the last day of September.

It is further understood and agreed by and between the respective parties hereto that this contract shall be interpreted and construed in the light of the provisions of the part of the Statutes of the University, entitled University Faculty, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
