# **Biography**

Dr. Lewis Benedictus Smedes (August 20, 1921 - December 19, 2002) taught Christian Ethics and Theology at Fuller Theological Seminary. Though firmly within the School of Theology, Dr. Smedes played a key role in the integration of Psychology and Theology at Fuller Seminary.

Smedes, best-selling author of more than 15 books, was a visiting professor in the philosophy of religion at Fuller from 1968 to 1970, when he was invited to join the faculty. In 1990, he accepted a chair for the integration of psychology and theology in Fuller's School of Psychology, where he served until retiring in 1995.

Smedes was a sought-after speaker and the author of best-selling books, some of which were translated into several languages. In the classroom, in the pulpit, and in his writings, Smedes frequently discussed the difficult but important issue of forgiveness. Among his book titles are Forgive and Forget (1984), All Things Made New (1970); Shame and Grace: Healing the Shame We Don't Deserve (1993); Mere Morality: What God Expects From Ordinary People (1983); Choices: Making Right Decisions in a Complex World (1986); Caring and Commitment (1988); How Can It Be All Right When Everything is All Wrong (1982) and My God and I: a spiritual memoir (2003).

# **Scope and Content**

The Papers of Lewis B. Smedes includes his personal notes on theological, spiritual and psychological topics, reviews of his publications, some correspondence and several boxes of topical files for course, sermon and publication preparation. Bulk dates range withing Dr. Smedes' later years at Fuller Theological Seminary.
