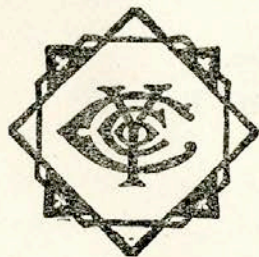

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## HOW TO KEEP PARISH RECORDS

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Every Parish and Mission should keep three books or sets of books. The CHURCH REGISTER is kept by the Rector; the MINUTE BOOK by the Clerk of the Vestry; the FINANCIAL ACCOUNT BOOKS by the Treasurer. All three are to be open to all proper parties at all times.

The CHURCH REGISTER contains the vital records of the Parish, and is legal evidence as to births, marriages, and burials. It is to be examined by the Bishop at his annual visitation. The records should be entered *immediately* upon performance of any office, by the minister himself. The Marriage Record should invariably be signed by each of those parties specified in the Canon. [In the larger Registers, the Marriage Register constitutes a second volume].

All permanent entries should be recorded in black ink. Temporary Memoranda as to Communicants and Families—as "can't find," "ceased to communicate," etc., if made, should be in pencil as easy to erase and not proper as matter of permanent record. No name should ever be erased or scratched. Every name, once entered, must be accounted for in the Register. Where communicants are transferred to another Parish, enter "transferred to A. B.," with date. If Letter of Transfer is not issued, enter "removed to A. B." It is wise in such instances, to apprise the Rector of the parish into which such parties have moved.

A new name entered on any page should also be entered in the Index. The Index should refer to each page upon which any name is entered for any purpose.

The List of Families entered in the Appendix is also required by canon, though not properly a part of the Parish Register. It is bound together with the smaller Registers in order to save the expense and trouble of keeping two books.

Suitable blanks and certificates for Marriage, Letters of Transfer, Application for Baptism and other offices, Blanks for Family Record, etc. may be obtained from the Publishers of this Register.

Mrs William Sturdy left by her last will & testament money to found a church in the district between Buffalo Avenue & Pine Avenue. A Sunday School was started in the home of Thomas Gordon, 520, 25<sup>th</sup> St, and as the school grew it was moved to a house on 19<sup>th</sup> St, then to a stone, Pine Ave and 22<sup>nd</sup> St. In September, 1914, John Sagar, a candidate for Holy Orders came to assist the rector in the work. A lot, <sup>135</sup>184 ft. on Pine Ave & <sup>304</sup>205 ft on 23<sup>rd</sup> St that was bought and a temporary building was erected and used on the first Sunday of 1915 - January 3<sup>rd</sup>

Guild Hall built on rear of church. Later

Rev. Richard Warner became Asst. Minister July 1<sup>st</sup> 1919, died January 4<sup>th</sup> 1921 (see page 170). Mr. Charles H. Burton, a postulant for Holy Orders came as Lay Assistant to the Rector, June 1<sup>st</sup> 1921. 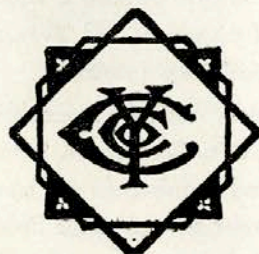

## CANON OF MARRIAGE AND DIVORCE.

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ENACTED BY THE GENERAL CONVENTION OF 1904. IN EFFECT ON AND AFTER  
JANUARY 1, 1905.

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§ 1. Ministers of this Church shall be careful to secure the observance of the law of the State governing the civil contract of marriage in the place where the service shall be performed.

§ 2. [i.] No Minister shall solemnize a marriage except in the presence of at least two witnesses.

[ii.] Every Minister shall without delay formally record in the proper register the name, age, and residence of each party. Such record shall be signed by the Minister who solemnizes the marriage, and, if practicable, by the married parties, and by at least two witnesses of the marriage.

§ 3. No Minister, knowingly after due inquiry, shall solemnize the marriage of any person who has a divorced husband or wife still living, if such husband or wife has been put away for any cause arising after marriage. But this canon shall not be held to apply to the innocent party in a divorce for adultery; *provided*, that before the application for such remarriage a period of not less than one year shall have elapsed, after the granting of such divorce; and that satisfactory evidence touching the facts in the case, including a copy of the Court's Decree, and Record if practicable, with proof that the defendant was personally served or appeared in the action, be laid before the Ecclesiastical Authority, and such Ecclesiastical Authority, having taken legal advice thereon, shall have declared in writing that in his judgment the case of the applicant conforms to the requirements of this canon; and, *Provided* further: That it shall be within the discretion of any Minister to decline to solemnize any marriage.

§ 4. If any Minister of this Church shall have reasonable cause to doubt whether a person desirous of being admitted to Holy Baptism, or to Confirmation, or to the Holy Communion, has been married otherwise than as the Word of God and discipline of this Church allow, such Minister, before receiving such person to these ordinances, shall refer the case to the Bishop for his godly judgment thereupon: *Provided, however*, That no Minister shall in any case refuse these ordinances to a penitent person in imminent danger of death.

## HOW TO USE THE MARRIAGE REGISTER

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The Canon governing the use of this Register will be found on the preceding page. It is required that each entry "shall be signed by the Minister who solemnizes the marriage, and, if practicable, by the married parties, and by at least two witnesses of the marriage."

A convenient way to secure these signatures, will be to have the Marriage Register, lying open at the appropriate page, resting on a table standing in the Church Porch, pen, ink, and writing conveniences being also provided. The preliminary entries prior to the signatures should have been made in advance. As the bridal party passes out of the Church, they should be stopped as they pass the table, and the signatures should then and there be affixed. The bride, signing first, should append her full signature, thus: "Mary Elisabeth (Jones) Smith," her maiden name being within the parentheses. The signature of the groom will follow, then those of "at least two witnesses." Space is provided in the Register for the signatures of eight witnesses. The officiating minister should sign last of all, immediately after he has returned from the vestry, and before the Register has been removed from the table.

Detailed instructions should have been given to the Bridal party in advance, as to order and place of signatures and as to the style of the signature of the Bride; and an usher or attendant should have the custody of the Register and the table which supports it, continuously, before, during, and after the solemnization, until the Register is removed from the Church.

In the event of the marriage of any divorced person, according to the terms of the Canon, care should be taken to enter the date of the decree granting such divorce, which must be "not less than one year" prior to the time of this marriage; and also the name of the Court which granted the decree. The "satisfactory evidence touching the facts in the case," with "a copy of the Court's decree, and Record if practicable," and the "judgment" of the "Ecclesiastical Authority" "in writing," should in every instance be carefully preserved among the Parish archives, unless the Ecclesiastical Authority in any Diocese may arrange (as would be wise) for the lodging and safe keeping of all such papers among diocesan archives.
