
Reserve materials at Ladd are frequently in high demand. There are short loan periods in place to allow access for all students in the class. Please make note of the due time for each item checked out. Items returned late are fined at \$2.00 per hour. The fine increases to \$4.00 per hour after four hours overdue. These fines are in place to ensure fair access for all students in the class.

- Circulation Desk Reserves may have a two hour, 24 hour, or three day loan period. Most print materials may be taken from the library.
- Audio Desk Reserves all have a four hour loan period. <u>A/V</u>
 materials may not be removed from the library, except by the
 professor who has placed the reserve. There are facilities
 within the Audio/ Video Area to view and listen to these
 reserves.












