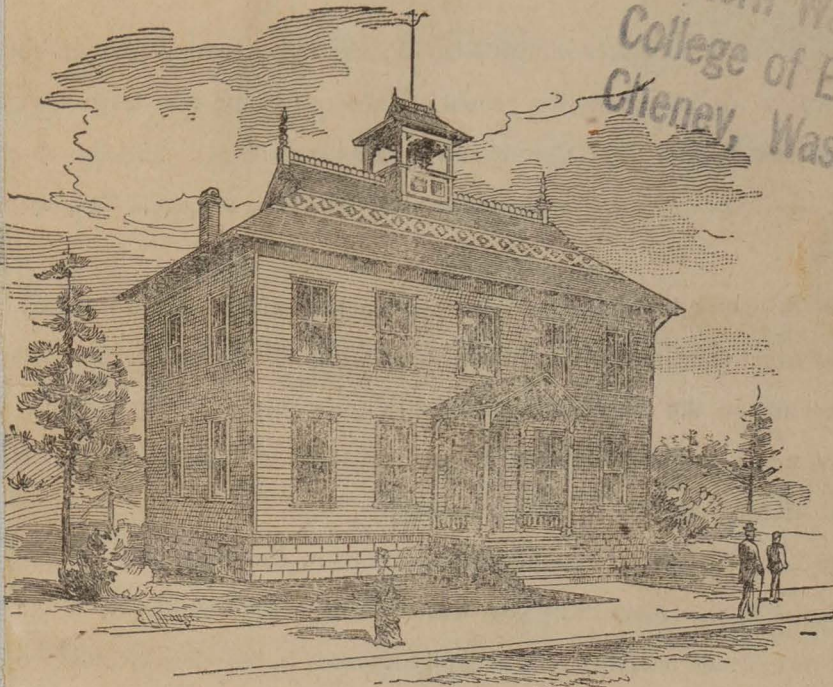

The Academy building is beautifully situated in the city of Cheney on an eminence commanding beautiful views of the Cœur d' Alene mountains.

The climate of Cheney is equitable and healthful. The different religious denominations have established places for worship to which students of the Academy will be cordially welcomed. Good accommodations will be provided either in boarding houses or private families for students from outside the city.
