April 3<sup>d</sup> 1862

My dear Jennie:

I wrote to  
you this morning but  
as it was not then  
certain that we <sup>would</sup> go  
on farther I now  
inform you that  
we will positively  
"march on" tomorrow  
morning at day break.  
The rebels may give  
us battle tomorrow  
or perhaps they will  
retreat and delay

The fight a day or two.  
They must fight some-  
-where between here and  
Richmond or give up  
the rebellious ghost.  
Direct my future letters  
to Washington. They will  
be sent to me from  
thence wherever I am.

We are in good  
spirits. You will hear from  
me again as soon as <sup>we</sup> ~~will~~  
rest. God bless you love  
and Joline.
