#### Historical Background:

In 1945, Frs. Edward L. Murphy and Richard V. Lawlor discussed the need to open a school for delayed vocations for veterans of military service who desired to enter the religious life. In 1946, Fr. George M. Murphy planned and publicized such a school to be opened in Boston, MA using the Campion House, in Osterley, England, as a model. The school in England had opened as a school for delayed vocations after World War I. Its purpose was to teach Latin so the students could go on to seminaries, which required a foundation of Latin for acceptance.

The St. Philip Neri School opened in September, 1946 in Boston and a second branch opened in Haverhill, MA in 1949. The Haverhill, MA school closed in 1964 and the Boston, MA school closed in 1969. The School closed due to a dwindling number of students because United States seminaries in the mid-1960s were no longer requiring knowledge of Latin for admission as the liturgy was being conducted in English.

The average enrollment was around ninety students per year from all over the United States and Canada. Graduates of the school were candidates for priesthood in over fifty diocese and thirty religious and missionary societies. In its first twenty years, 1633 students were certified and of this number 375 continued studies in seminaries (1967-68 Catalogue, p. 5). The average certification took about nine months. Between 1952 and 1969, 544 alumni were ordained: 371 as diocesan priests for 96 dioceses and 173 religious order priests for 33 orders (Closure of school letter).

The first Director of the School was Rev. George M. Murphy, S.J. from 1946 until 1958 when Rev. James F. Geary, S.J. was appointed. In 1964, Rev. Walter J. Martin, S.J. was named Director and he served until the school closed in 1969. Fr. Martin then went to work at Boston College High School and continued to administer the records from that location.

#### Scope and Content:

The collection consists of yearbooks, deeds & correspondence pertaining to the Haverhill, MA property, course catalogs, correspondence, and a written history of the school.

This collection is open for research with the exception of the folder marked as "Restricted".
