## CITATION

The teachings of Sister Thea Bowman, F.S.P.A., extend far beyond the standard textbook. They are about the Good News of faith, hope, joy, and courage.

A nationally known educator, liturgist and gospel singer, Sister Thea is alive with the belief that we are all God's children and should treat each other with love and respect. For children in poverty, for whom she has worked tirelessly, she sees a loving self-image as a critical tool for survival.

Sister Thea, the granddaughter of a slave, was born and raised in Canton, a segregated rural town in Mississippi. When the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration opened a school for black children in Canton in the late 1940s, she was so moved by the Christian witness of these women that she entered their convent in La Crosse, Wisconsin.

This valiant woman embraced education with comparable vigor, obtaining a bachelor of arts degree in English from Viterbo College in La Crosse, and a masters and doctorate from The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. An acknowledged authority on Faulkner, she holds her doctorate in English language and literature.

An experienced college professor, lecturer, and performer, Sister Thea returned to her native Mississippi in 1978 to evangelize her own people. As a spokesperson for black Catholics, one who is dedicated to cross-cultural understanding, she has gained the respect of all races.

In 1984 Sister Thea learned she had bone cancer. Despite this debilitating illness, she has continued a dedicated ministry which infuses a love of God into everyone she meets. She still manages over 100 public appearances throughout the country each year.

In addition, she is a consultant for Intercultural Awareness for the Diocese of Jackson, Mississippi, and a member of the faculty at Xavier University, New Orleans, Louisiana, where she is a professor of black Catholic studies.

Her special gifts have been featured on CBS' "60 Minutes" and will be recognized in a motion picture being produced by Harry Belafonte. She was also honored at the White House as one of a group of courageous cancer survivors.

## CITATION

With roots in small-town America and the windswept Oklahoma plains, Douglas Edwards reached out to the horizon and traveled many miles, leading him to the pinnacle of his profession as a broadcast journalist.

Douglas Edwards was a pioneer, breaking ground in the 1940s in the wide open, unplowed field of television news. He earned a place in the history of the industry for excellence, innovation, and integrity, expanding forever our narrow vision of the world.

His CBS Monday through Friday evening broadcast became the first coast-to-coast television news program. In 1948, he participated in the first television gavel-to-gavel coverage of the national political conventions.

He was also one of the first journalists to use news cameras on location, transmitting into homes across the country the fast-breaking story, be it the rampaging floods of the Missouri River or the exclusive account of the sinking of the Italian liner Andrea Doria.

Distinguishing himself previously in the radio medium, he served during the early 1940s as chief of the CBS News Paris Bureau. Later as a roving journalist he traveled throughout Europe reporting on the rebuilding of a war-ravaged continent.

In his broadcast career spanning 56 years, 46 with CBS, colleagues called him “friend,” “mentor,” “gentleman” — unanimous accolades in a highly-competitive industry.

His many honors include a Peabody Award for “Best Television News” (1956), a special Service Award from the Joint Defense Appeal of the American Jewish Committee and the Anti-Defamation League of B’nai B’rith (1961), the first Freedom of Speech Award from the Georgia Association of Broadcasters (1975), and Honorary Doctor of Letters degrees from St. Bonaventure University (1967) and Ohio Northern University (1981). In 1986, he was the recipient of Marist College’s Lowell Thomas Award.

As President and now Chief Executive Officer of the company which bears the family name, Mr. Rich has been responsible for the construction of major office complexes, civic works projects and housing developments throughout the nation. The urban renewal of Baltimore bears his indelible stamp as well.

An inventor, Mr. Rich is the holder of several U.S. patents for innovative modular construction.

The Stamford-born and Cornell- and Princeton-educated (B.S. in Engineering) developer served with the U.S. Marines during World War II and again in the early 1950s, emerging as a 1st Lieutenant.

His concern for young people, and generous support for education and the arts help explain his well-deserved reputation as an outstanding humanitarian. As Trustee and Vice Chairman of the University of Connecticut, he is integrally involved in providing first-rate undergraduate and graduate opportunities for the citizens of our state. Formerly President of the Low-Heywood Thomas School in Stamford, he continues to serve that fine institution as Trustee.

Founding President of the Stamford Center for the Arts, and President and Director of the Stamford State Opera, he has provided the inspiration and vision that is reflected in our region's cultural renaissance.

A sensitive man with strong family and religious values, Mr. Rich and his wife, Jean are the loving parents of six children.

## ON ACADEMIC DRESS . . .

Tradition holds that the cap and gown were first used in ancient Greece when only youths of wealthy parents or ones with patrons attended school. The wise teachers of the time believed that fine clothing and jewels should not be worn by the scholar but rather, that he should wear the garments of the workman.

In the United States, the gown commonly worn for both the associate's and bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves (with a slit for the arm). It is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve, open at the wrist. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped open sleeves. All gowns are black and without trimming with the exception of the doctor's which normally is trimmed with velvet, has three bars or chevrons on the sleeves and may be in a distinctive color(s) governed by the school granting that degree. Master's and doctor's gowns may be worn open.

Upon graduation, each student of old carried a mortarboard showing him to be a mason of the future destined to build empires or cities or fountains of wisdom on the firm foundation of knowledge. To this day, graduates wear the mortarboard cap and gown, symbolizing that they are builders of the future of mankind.

The history of the hood with which degree recipients are invested dates back to 13th century England. Whether its origin is ecclesiastical or secular has never been settled. Hoods are two and one-half feet long for the associate's, three feet for the bachelor's, three and one-half for the master's and four feet for the doctor's degree. The hood is lined with the colors of the institution — red and white, in the case of Sacred Heart University. The color of the trim indicates the academic degree — white for arts, letters and humanities (B.A.) . . . golden yellow for science (B.S.).

The hoods of those with graduate degrees, as well as the tassels on the mortarboards of the undergraduates, are often in the color associated with the academic field of specialization, as follows:
