# PLANNING & EXECUTION

- Cast a wide net Recruit participants far in advance.
- **Do a dry run** To ensure you have enough time & test your recording device.
  - (We used a ClearOne Chat mic & Camtasia to record audio)
- **Provide refreshments/giveaways** Our students loved the healthy options!
- Break the ice! We had students "grade" the library.

A: "Yes, I can't imagine how much you spend on it!"


### Master's In Public Health Program Focus Group Report

#### Grading Activity
