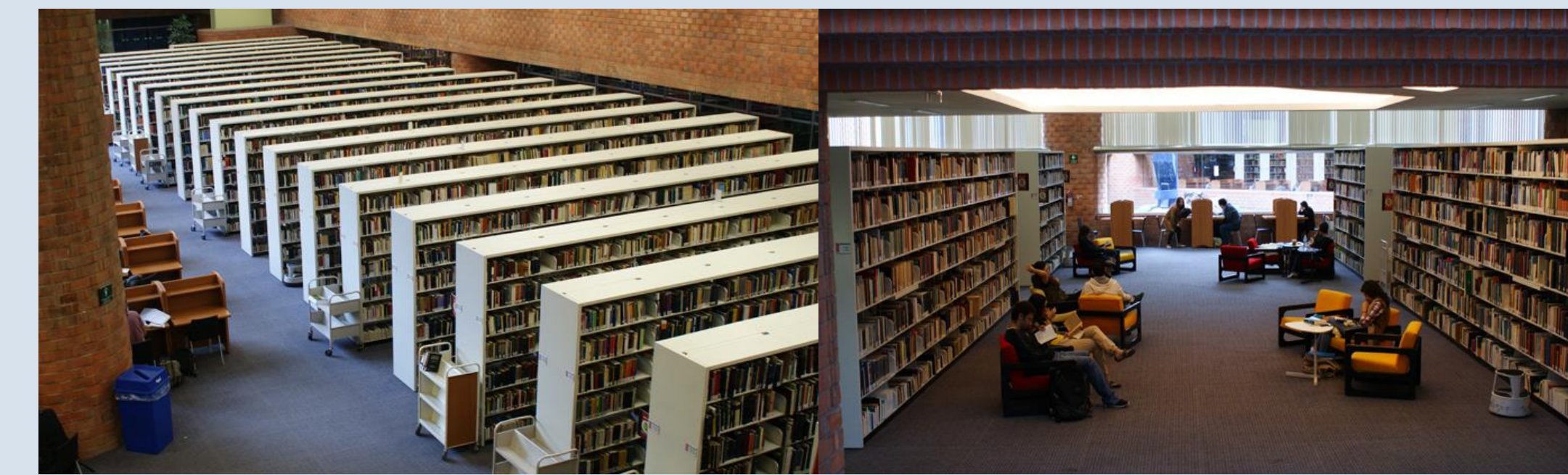

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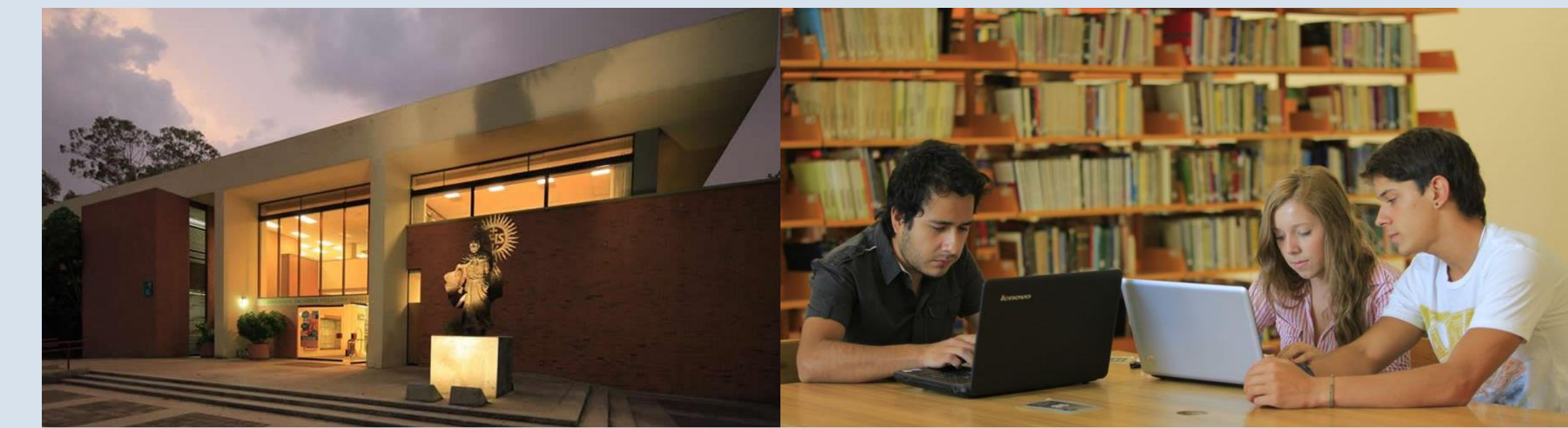
## WHY ARE WE RESEARCHING THIS?

What is the role of the University Library in Undergraduate Education?

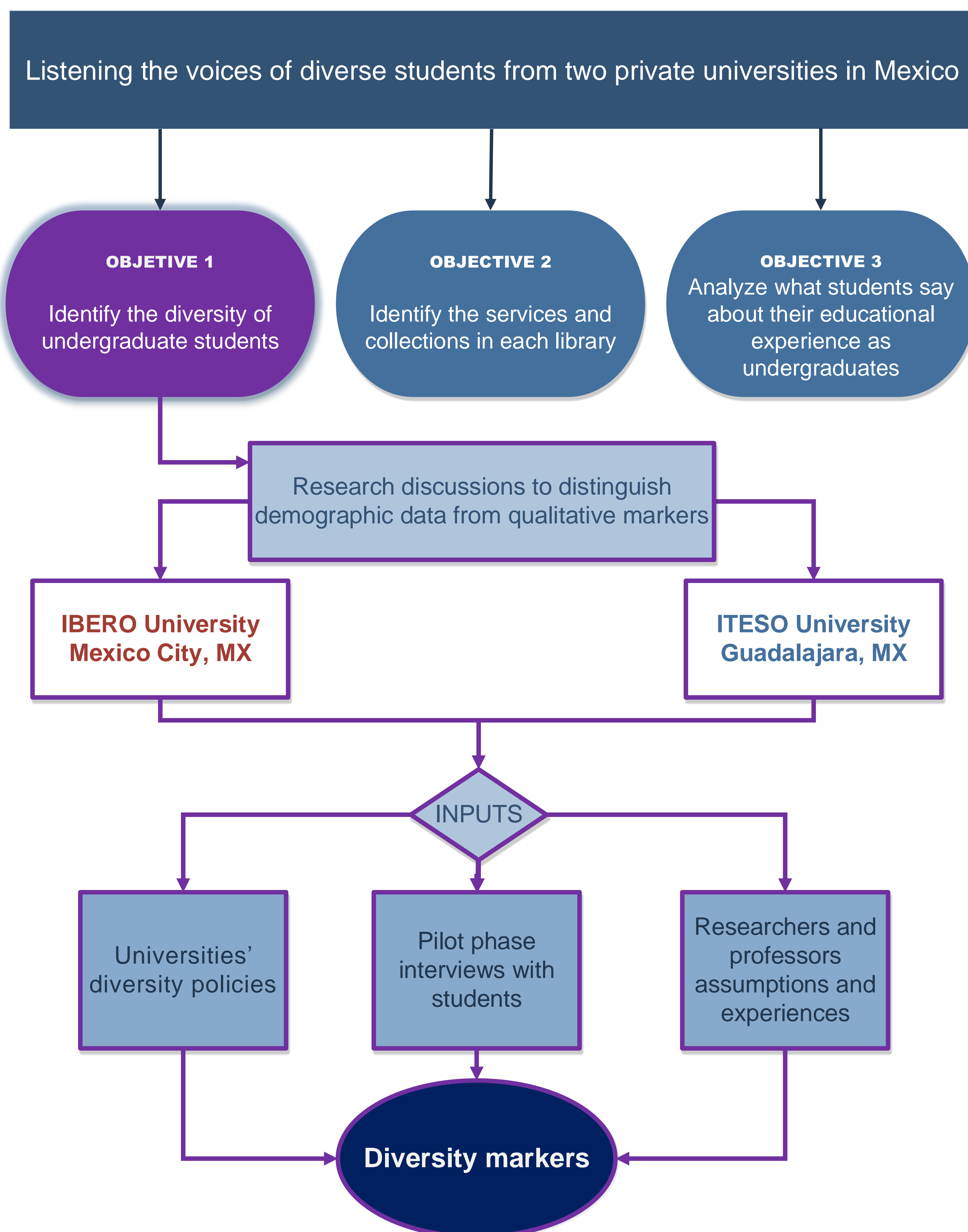

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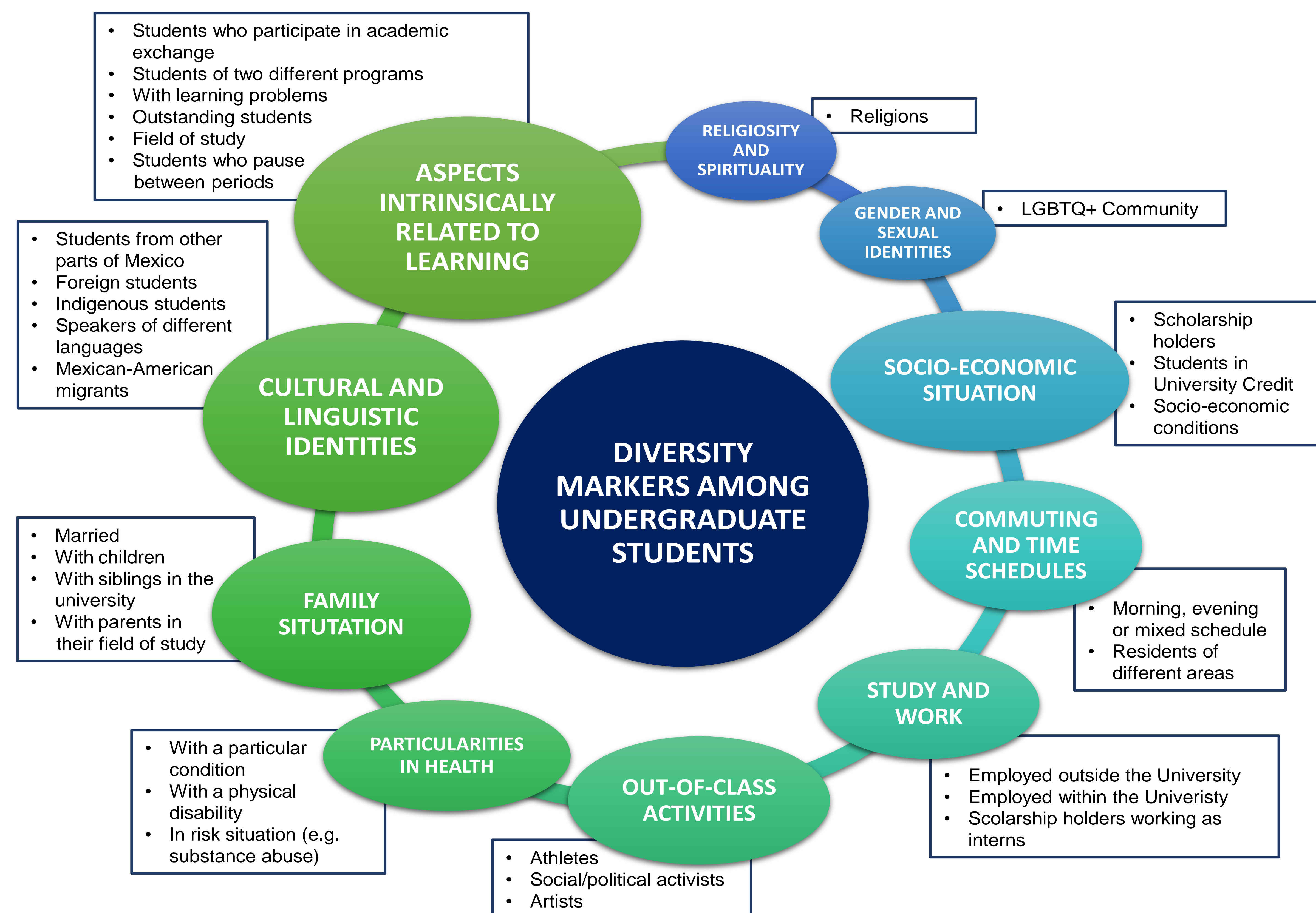
