## TEXTBOOK COSTS ARE RISING

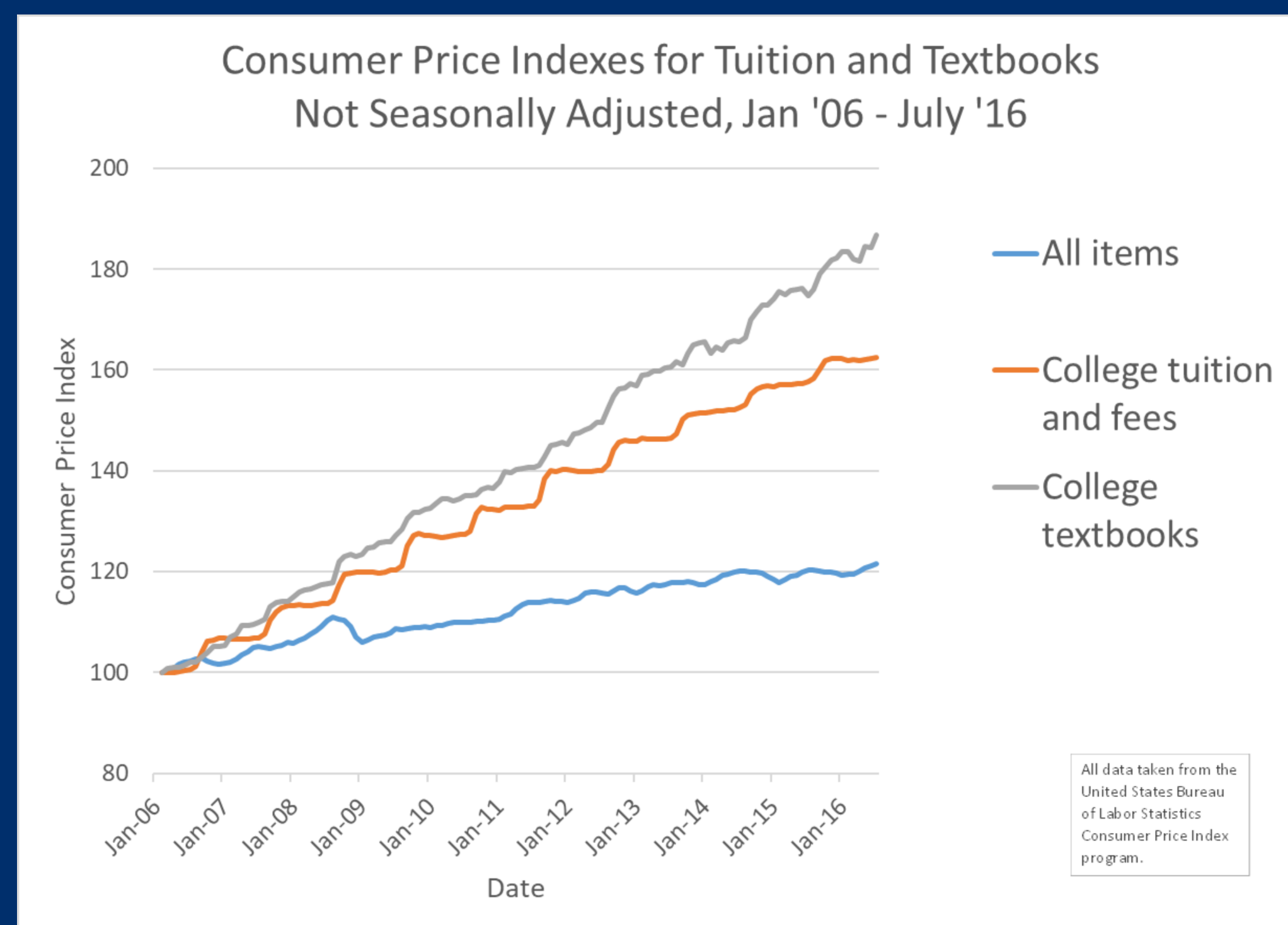

So, what options do you have to keep your own book costs lower?

## IS YOUR BOOK AT THE LIBRARY?

The library doesn't buy traditional textbooks, but we may have other materials used in your classes (like novels, movies, or nonfiction books.)

### COURSE RESERVES

Your professor may have asked for a book to be set aside for you and your classmates to use. Be sure to check in MUSCAT Plus for physical texts, or in Moodle for digital copies.

### INTERLIBRARY LOAN

If a book you need is checked out, or you don't see a copy in the library, you can ask for it to be sent from another library. Unfortunately, you can't request traditional textbooks this way.

Even a physical copy of this book only costs \$30!
