An Introduction

Agricultural Information Center History

- Before 1964 the Agricultural Library was a room in the local Agricultural Experiment Station which is housed under the College of Agriculture.
- In 1964 the Agricultural Science Building opened and the library became an Associate Library in UK Libraries. It was no longer under the College of Agriculture.
- The Agricultural Library stayed an Associate Library until 1998 when the physical collection was transferred to Young Library. At this point the Agricultural Library became a Branch Library and it remains so today.

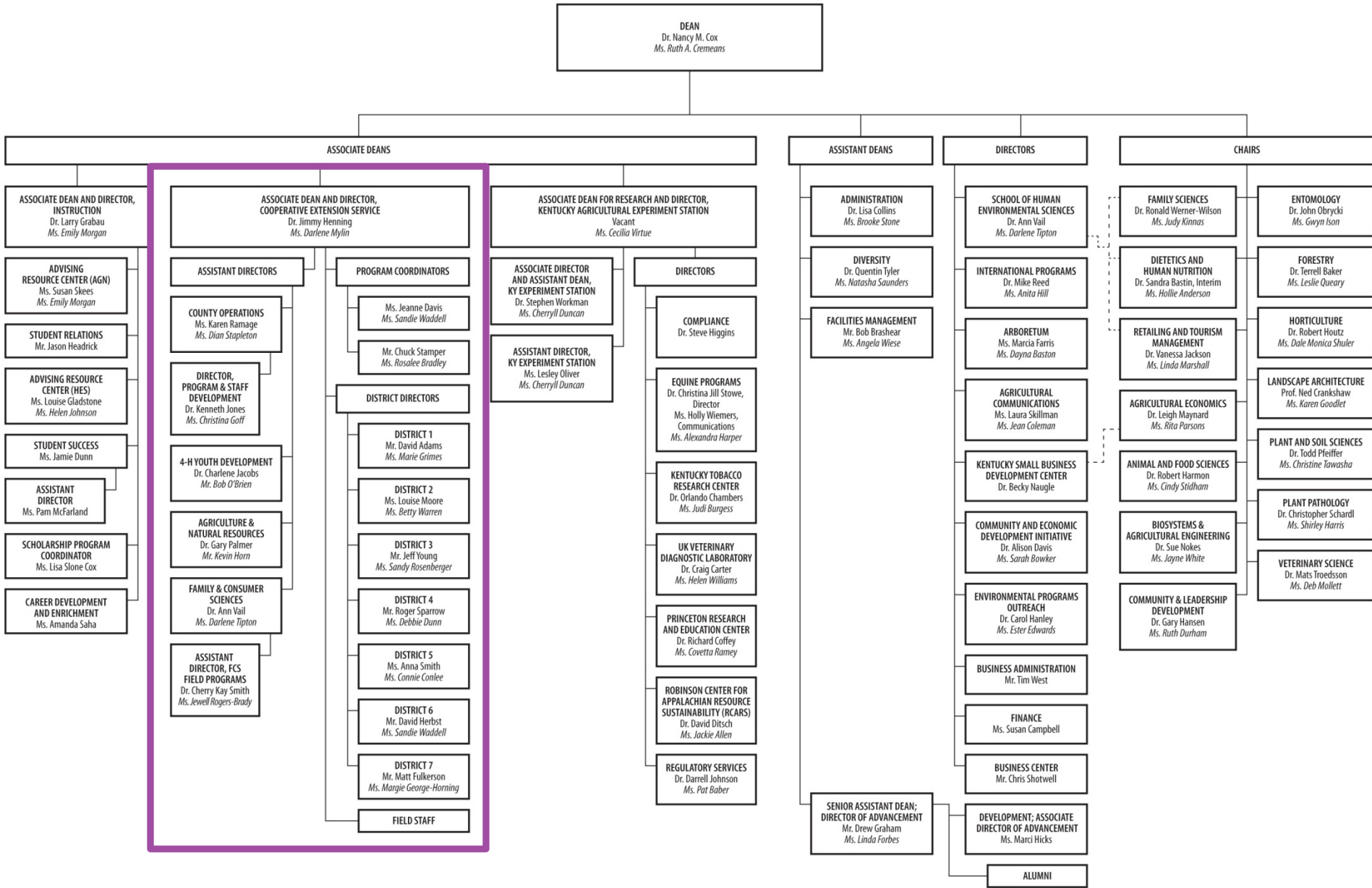
Staying Visible



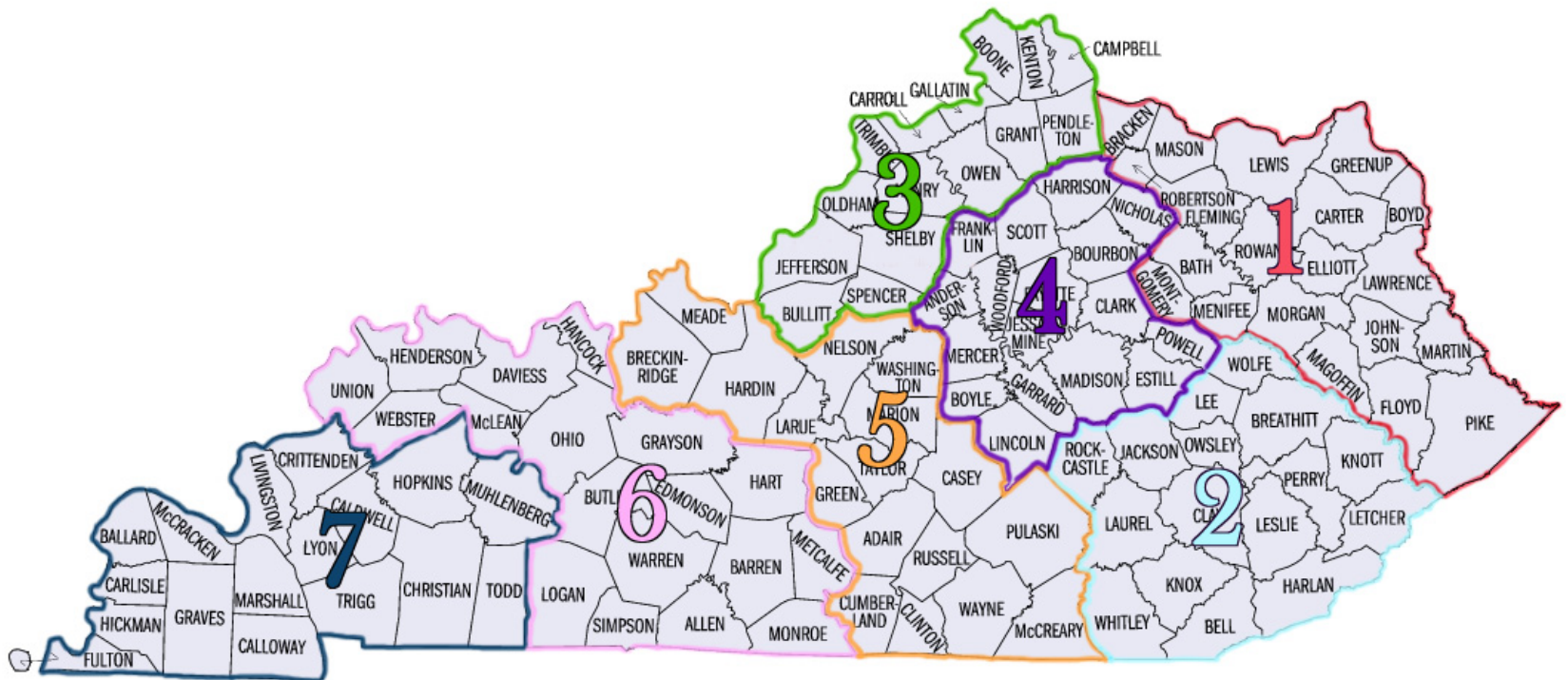


ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

University of Kentucky - College of Agriculture, Food and Environment

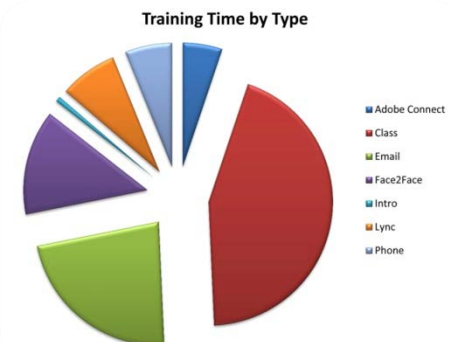
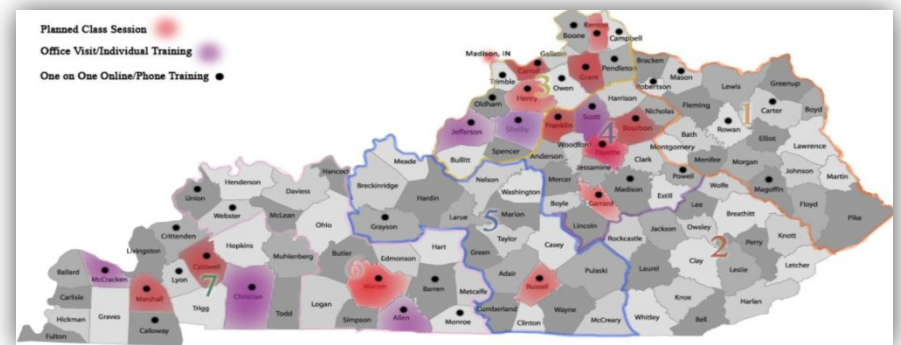

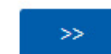
