Dear Mrs. von Allmen:

The Committee on Directories is preparing to compile the 1974 edition of the <u>Directory of Law Libraries</u> which Commerce Clearing House so graciously publishes for the Association every other year. The computer printouts will soon be sent to all libraries which were listed in the 1972 <u>Directory</u>.

We are seeking your help in locating new libraries which have been started since the last <u>Directory</u> or which have increased in size to warrant inclusion in the <u>Directory</u>. If a library contains 10,000 or more volumes, it will be listed regardless of the membership status of its librarian. If the librarian is a member of AALL, the library will be listed regardless of its size.
