
Dear Jane:

**WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE - LIBRARY AND
INFORMATION SERVICES**

PUBLIC LAW 93-568; 88 STAT. 1855

Whereas access to information and ideas is indispensable to the development of human potential, the advancement of civilization, and the continuance of enlightened self-government; and

Whereas the preservation and the dissemination of information and ideas are the primary purpose and function of libraries and information centers; and

Whereas maximum realization of the potential inherent in the use of advanced technology by libraries and information centers requires cooperation through planning for, and coordination of, the services, resources, and leadership of law libraries: Now therefore, be it

Resolved to request the American Association of Law Libraries to authorize and send delegates to the White House Conference on Library and Information Services to be scheduled not later than 1978.

Adopted by the Southeastern Chapter, American Association of Law Libraries in formal session Friday, May 23, 1975.
