- Chinook salmon in decline
- 20% of shellfish beds closed due to pollution
- 14 million pounds of pollutants go into Puget Sound annually




RAIN GARDENS

catch water from roofs and gently release it into the landscape swales catch water and filter it slowly back into the ground

URBAN TREE COVER


