



THE following Record attempts to account for more than two-thirds of those who have graduated from the Law Department of the University of Michigan since its establishment.

The migratory nature of attorneys in search of a practice leaves little reliance to be placed for any great length of time upon the stated addresses of members of the latest classes. The graduates of 1875, with the exception of those who are starred in the following list, are confessedly "unsettled;" they can be reached or heard from, however, for some months to come at the addresses given. There is yet much uncertainty also as to the locations fixed upon by some of the classmen of 1874. Generally, however, the Record may be regarded as substantially correct. Where it is not absolutely so, its statement will doubtless serve as a clue for further inquiry.

I am so greatly indebted to so many of the law-graduates for the information gathered here, that I cannot undertake to discriminate among them in offering them my very sincere and hearty acknowledgments for their kindness, whether they have simply confirmed my own previous knowledge of their own addresses, or have supplied me with those of fifty others. The stars in the list must serve to show to whom these thanks are due.

I take this opportunity, also, of expressing the earnest acknowledgments which I have necessarily neglected to make hitherto, for the many kind expressions of personal interest which have reached me in the course of the extensive correspondence involved in the compilation of the Record.

The stars in the following list indicate that the persons against whose names they appear have replied to my circular of inquiry, or that I have personal knowledge as to their places of residence. The bracketed clauses show the fact of academical graduation at some college or university, and, in some cases, the year of such graduation. The names in full-faced type are of those who have been Presidents of the Association of Law Alumni. "Com." means Commissioner; "J. P.," of course means Justice of the Peace; "J. Pr." means Judge of Probate; "P. A." means Prosecuting Attorney; "Co. Att'y" means County Attorney, and "P. M." (which is Postmaster) is understood by all who have heard of Nasby. Where the name of the State is not given Michigan is meant. The attempt has been made to show who were in the army during the Great Rebellion, but information on this point is somewhat scanty. In some cases information is credited to authorities from whom I have obtained it, as to E. T. Waite, Esq., of Toledo, one of the class secretaries of 1871, Martindale's and Smith's Legal Gazetteers, etc.


