### About the Soloist

Erica started her piano study at age five with Mrs. Olive Meyer. She continued her study with Mrs. Vicki Cavendish; currently, she is under the instruction of Dr. Leslie Petteys.

Since the age of four, Erica has regularly attended performances of the West Virginia Symphony Orchestra and various arts organizations. She enjoys an eclectic array of musical styles: classical, jazz, Broadway, opera, rock, swing, and many more. "Music," she says, "is a language that the entire world can understand."

Erica has been featured by the programs of the Kanawha Forum, Thanks! Plain and Simple, Good Night and the WV Governor's Tree Lighting Ceremony. Throughout her study, she also has had the honor to attend masterclasses conducted by renowned artists such as Antonio Pompa-Baldi.
