RSS

- What is RSS?
 - Really Simple Syndication / Rich Site Summary
 - Data delivered via XML file (a feed) to a software program (a reader) designed to translate this type of file
- Uses of RSS
 - Push content to end users
 - News sites, corporate, libraries

RSS (cont'd)

- Tools Required
 - Feed generator to create the files
 - Reader to read/display the files
 - Web-based readers integrated into other services
 - My Yahoo!
 - Blogger.com
 - Firefox / Opera / Safari browsers
 - Standalone software applications (clients), a.k.a. aggregators
 - Sage -- <http://sage.mozdev.org/>
 - Mozilla Thunderbird -- <http://www.mozilla.com/thunderbird/>
 - SharpReader -- <http://www.sharpreader.net/>
