EXPLANATORY NOTES

Because different types of information are filed differently, several subsections of this bibliography have been developed: periodicals, newspaper clippings index, urban bibliographies, and data bank files.

Our collection of periodicals includes newsletters, monthly publications, and reports that come to our office regularly.

The newspaper clippings index is a comprehensive file of newspaper articles from the <u>Lincoln Star</u>, <u>Lincoln Evening Journal</u>, <u>Omaha World Herald</u>, <u>West Omaha-Dundee Sun</u>, and the <u>New York Times</u>. The articles filed cover a wide range of topics dealing with local issues and problems.

The file of urban bibliographies includes a wide range of topics useful as sources for further reading on urbanism.

The data bank section of this bibliography encompasses the bulk of the data bank/information center documents.*

The filing number of each document is recorded to the left of the title. Document titles are annotated when they are not self-explanatory. We have included author and publisher as well as date and place of publication in each entry, whenever this information was available.

The index charts (blue pages) were designed to give our readers an indication of the type of information available for use. The information is divided into two general areas: (1) Omaha Standard Metropolitan Statistical Area (SMSA) and (2) areas other than the Omaha SMSA. The list of topics on the left hand side of the index corresponds to the filing categories in the information center.

The concepts were broken into two general categories: (1) human (dealing with social or social psychological factors) and (2) physical (dealing with physical or material elements). To determine whether or not the data bank contains information relating to a certain concept in the Omaha area, the user may look for the listing of that topic in the index. The numbers following the listed topics are the filing numbers of relevant documents. Since any one document may relate to several topics, many of the numbers will appear more than once on the charts.

Most of the topics are self-explanatory, but some need additional comments. "Geography-urban" is used for those documents that deal with the general geographic information of the city(s). Documents that are concerned with the specific city center are classified under "geography-central city."

Documents filed under University of Nebraska Medical Center, U.N. at Lincoln, and U.N. at Omaha deal with these particular institutions. Some of these documents have been filed according to the particular institution at which they were published.
