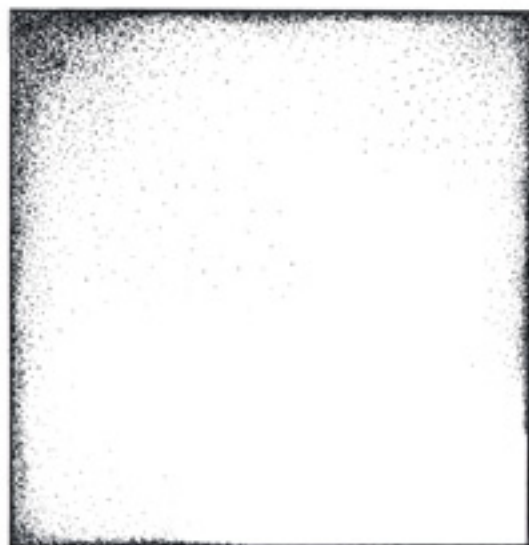
DAVID SHRIMP } IN THE TRADITION OF HAIKU
