### Discovering Louis Grell

The first comprehensive exhibition of works by renowned American muralist and Iowa native **Louis Grell** was showcased in the UNO Art Gallery from January 17 through February 20, 2014.

Arguably, Grell's murals are far better known than Grell himself. A native of Council Bluffs, Iowa, his work has been showcased in the Times Square Paramount Hotel in New York City, Chicago's Gateway Theatre and Union Station in St. Louis, among other locations; however, he has never had a show dedicated to his work, which also includes paintings, illustrations and commercial art, until now.

Opened in 1992, the UNO Art Gallery is a professional exhibition spaces consisting of two large galleries (1,500 square feet) and a Hexagon gallery (675 square feet) plus adjoining offices, a kitchen, and a storage facility.

The gallery presents contemporary art (made in the last 20 years) by artists with regional and national reputations. These exhibitions expose students to the diversity and vitality of contemporary visual culture and support the educational mission of the School of the Arts. In addition to a bi-annual exhibition of work by UNO Art Faculty, the gallery's annual schedule includes BFA Thesis Exhibitions at the end of the fall and spring semesters and Juried Student Shows with prizes awarded by a noted regional artist or arts professional. Opening receptions, which are held for every exhibition, are free and open to the public.

The gallery also hosts a variety of events (lectures, gallery talks, tours, **UNO Friends of Art** events, and other programs) to supplement exhibitions. These events nurture and sustain the social, creative, and intellectual life of the department while providing opportunities to meet members and supporters of the Omaha art community.
