ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program. All doctoral degree recipients are indicated by a gold tassel.

UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM

As part of their Honors Program requirements, students undertake a research project that results in a Senior Honors Thesis. Students and their theses topics are listed at the end of the list of graduates. Students who have been designated in this booklet as Honors Program students have fulfilled the academic requirements of this program.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER AND ORDER OF THE TOWER RECIPIENT

JAMES H. SUTTLE

Today's commencement address, "You Can't Take, Take, Take From The Community Without Give, Give, Giving Something Back," will be delivered by James H. Suttle, executive vice president and director of corporate development for HDR Inc. of Omaha, Neb. As the recipient of the Order of the Tower, he embodies the spirit of his address.

Suttle currently directs HDR's entry into the new delivery systems of design-build, privatization and program management for all engineering and architecture business groups in the United States and worldwide. He also is responsible for the HDR Corporate Safety Program. HDR is the 31st largest architecture-engineering firm in the United States and has 50 offices worldwide.

A graduate of West Virginia University with a bachelor of science and master of science in civil engineering, Suttle has 30 years of experience in transportation planning, engineering and public works. He currently serves on the Nebraska Board of Engineers and Architects, and was that board's chair from 1996 to 1997. During his tenure, he successfully led the passage of a new engineering-architecture licensing law to replace an inadequate 60-year-old law. Currently, he is chairing the subcommittee to translate this new law into enforceable rules and regulations.

Suttle's commitment to community service is exemplary. He was instrumental in the development of UNOmaha's College of Information Science and Technology and The Peter Kiewit Institute of Information Science, Technology and Engineering. He is a past president of the Omaha Downtown Rotary and is active in numerous civic groups. Politically, he is active on state and national issues affecting engineering business practices. He is a member of the National Society of Professional Engineers, the American Society of Civil Engineers and the Institute of Transportation Engineers. He is an active participant on the American Consulting Engineers Council and the Design Professionals Coalition.

For all his service and contributions to the University, it is with great pleasure that James H. Suttle is awarded the Order of the Tower.

The University of Nebraska at Omaha's highest non-academic award, the Order of the Tower, was first presented in 1964. Since that time, more than 70 individuals have received this honor, which symbolizes an ongoing commitment to the growth and development of the University.

The Order of the Tower is bestowed upon community leaders whose service and/or financial support has made it possible for the University to address the academic, cultural and economic needs of the people of Omaha and the citizens of Nebraska. Recipients of the award embody virtues and attributes valued highly by the University and are recognized as an example to others.

CHRISTINE MIXAN

Christine Mixan appreciates the value of her educational experience at the University of Nebraska at Omaha and the inspirational professors who helped shape her future. She'll underscore the importance of this experience in her commencement address titled "Simply Priceless."

Mixan graduates today summa cum laude with a bachelor of arts in communication/broadcasting and a minor in speech. She has been an active participant in campus life as a member of UNOmaha's speech team and the OFA Ad Club. She received 11th place in national competition for persuasive speaking, and will compete nationally later this year as a member of the Ad Club.

During her time at UNOmaha, Mixan also served as chairperson for the Festivals Committee of the Student Programming Organization, wrote for The Gateway - UNOmaha's student newspaper - and has been a member of the Society of Professional Journalists, the Omicron Delta Kappa Honor Society, the Phi Kappa Phi Honor Society and the Golden Key National Honor Society.

She was named to the Dean's List at UNOmaha each semester of her collegiate career, was named the "Outstanding Undergraduate Student in Broadcasting" in the spring of 1997 and 1999, and was presented with the "Student Leader Award" from the Student Programming Organization in the spring of 1996.

After graduation, Mixan will pursue a master's degree in communication at UNOmaha. Her career goals include working as a reporter or anchor in a television news department, specializing in either investigative, consumer or entertainment reporting. She also would like to work in the world of business as a corporate trainer and seminar presenter.

CHANCELLOR'S MEDAL RECIPIENT

JOANNE A. LOFTON

For more than 25 years, JoAnne A. Lofton has exemplified the values of the University of Nebraska at Omaha. She currently serves as assistant dean of the College of Public Affairs and Community Service.

Born in Forsythe, Ga., and raised in Tuskegee Institute, Ala., Lofton grew up in a family responsible for the founding of Tuskegee University and Grambling State University. She obtained her bachelor's degree in chemistry and her master's degree in foods and nutrition/biochemistry from Tuskegee University in Alabama.

During the 1960s, Lofton was heavily involved in the fight for voting rights for African-Americans in Alabama. She testified before the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights in 1958 regarding the Tuskegee, Alabama, gerrymander/voting rights situation.

Throughout her career at UNOmaha, Lofton has worked on campus as a staff member, faculty member and administrator. She has been instrumental in the recruitment and retention of students, and is especially known for her retention efforts in the Goodrich Scholarship Program and in the College of Public Affairs and Community Service. She suggested developing a relationship with Grambling State University in Louisiana, which has resulted in the recruitment of African-American students to graduate programs at UNOmaha.

Lofton also has been instrumental in working with local groups to promote UNOmaha. In conjunction with The Omaha Chapter of the Links Inc., she helped re-establish its loan program, which is open to all students for emergency situations. She also has worked to promote the undergraduate chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha, the Chancellor's Commission on the Status of Women and the Black Studies Department at UNOmaha.

A nominator wrote, "To many African-American newcomers, UNOmaha is JoAnne Lofton. Creighton students know her, business people know her and, of course, many UNOmaha students know her. Her behind-the-scenes efforts have helped pave the way for many scholarship and internship opportunities for UNOmaha students. JoAnne epitomizes the enduring, substantive nature of this institution - honest, accepting, tough and knowledgeable."

In honor of her dedication and service, UNOmaha takes pride in recognizing JoAnne A. Lofton as the recipient of the Chancellor's Medal.

The Chancellor's Medal of the University of Nebraska at Omaha was established to recognize the contribution of faculty and administrative staff who embody the institution's mission and values. It is bestowed only to those within the University community who have demonstrated unusual excellence.

HONORARY DEGREE - DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

MARION MARSH BROWN

"...Trying to meet the challenge, the author of integrity, giving of himself, will produce something of lasting value to his fellowman, something with the proportions of dignity and decency and worth...

We are opening the privacy of our minds and our hearts to our readers and I suppose the many faces of our dreams... and we are seeking acceptance, hoping to touch a responsive chord in our readers' minds and hearts..."

Marion Marsh Brown - an excerpt from a Student Union address State University of Minnesota at Mankato June 24, 1969

Marion Marsh Brown wrote her first paid story at age 10. In the decades that followed, she joined the ranks of Willa Cather, Mari Sandoz and John G. Neihardt as one of Nebraska's most esteemed authors.

Born on a Nebraska farm and educated in a one-room country school, Brown expressed her talents early on in a variety of ways. She played the piano in concert, acted on stage and saved the royalties from her Sunday School newspaper stories to buy her hope chest flatware.

Brown obtained her undergraduate degree from Peru State College at the age of 18, then earned her master's degree from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and pursued doctoral studies at the University of Minnesota. She taught throughout Nebraska before arriving at the University of Nebraska at Omaha in 1953.

At UNOmaha, Brown held a joint appointment in the English department in the College of Arts and Sciences and the secondary education department in the College of Education. She taught classes in English literature and language as well as classes in methodology for undergraduate students planning to teach English in secondary schools. She also supervised these future English teachers in the classrooms of area schools.

Active in the local community and in statewide organizations, Brown frequently gave speeches, held seminars and coached others about the techniques of clear and readable writing. She stressed the necessity for using precise language, unconvoluted syntax, and a smooth and flowing style.

Although she has traveled widely throughout Europe, South America and Asia, Brown will always consider Nebraska her physical and spiritual home. She is the author of 19 books to date, both fiction and non-fiction. She is also the recipient of numerous honors and awards, including the Distinguished Service Award and an honorary doctoral degree from Peru State College, the Sandoz Award from the Nebraska State Library Association and the Sower Award from the Nebraska Humanities Council.

It is with great pleasure that Marion Marsh Brown is awarded the honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree from UNOmaha - an author and educator who has given abundantly of her intelligence, her talent, her common sense and her compassion to students and colleagues during her tenure at the university.

ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENT

JACK KORALESKI

Koraleski received a bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Nebraska at Omaha in 1972 and in June of that same year went to work for Union Pacific Railroad. He has held a variety of positions with Union Pacific, applying his expertise to responsibilities such as Information Technologies, Real Estate and various Administrative Departments. Also a UNOmaha MBA graduate (1981), Koraleski has been Controller of the U.P. Corporation, Executive Vice President of Finance and the Chief Financial Officer responsible for all financial planning and management functions for the Railroad's expansive 23-state system.

In March of this year Koraleski was promoted to Executive Vice President for Marketing and Sales. He also is a member of the Board of Trustees for Union Pacific Foundation and serves on the Board of Automated Monitoring and Controls, International, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Union Pacific.

He serves on various boards, including those for Bridges Investment Fund, Nebraska Methodist Hospital, the American Institute for Managing Diversity, and UNOmaha's College of Business Administration's National Advisory Committee. Koraleski also has been a tireless worker for the YWCA, having sponsored the Union Pacific YWCA campaign drive for the past ten years and twice serving as co-chair of the City-wide campaign. He currently serves on the YWCA's Advisory Board.

The University of Nebraska at Omaha Alumni Association awards the Citation for Alumnus Achievement Award to distinguished alumni. The awards are presented each year at spring commencement to graduates who have achieved distinction in their chosen fields.
