ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's and master's degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program.

ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENTS

The University of Nebraska at Omaha Alumni Association awards the Citation for Alumnus Achievement Award to distinguished alumni.

The awards are presented each year at spring commencement to graduates who have achieved distinction in their chosen fields.

This year's honorees are Kenneth Bird, Howard Hawks, Michael McLarney, and Carol Schrader.

KENNETH BIRD

For nearly 30 years since graduating from the University of Nebraska at Omaha in 1971, Kenneth Bird has devoted his life to educating this state's young men and women.

His career in the field began as a special education teacher aide at Westside High School. Today Bird is the superintendent of Westside Community Schools, a post he has held since 1992. Last year he was named Nebraska Superintendent of the Year.

In between, Bird has held a variety of positions with Westside Community Schools and also has been a consultant, supervisor and director with the Nebraska Department of Education. Somehow, he also manages an active life in the community, volunteering with many organizations, including the Boy Scouts, Children's Hospital and Junior Achievement.

HOWARD HAWKS

Howard Hawks has made a name for himself in the highly competitive field of energy companies since earning his Master of Business Administration degree in 1971.

As chairman and chief executive officer of Tenaska, Incorporated, an 11-year-old Omaha based company, he heads one of the nation's top independent power producers and sellers of power and natural gas. Last year, it topped the one billion dollar mark in revenues.

Hawks began his career in the early 1960s at General Motors Corporation. In 1966 he joined what was known then as InterNorth and later as Enron. Over the years he became president of three of Enron's subsidiary groups, but when the company relocated, Hawks and five of his co-workers formed Tenaska. Today, the company is a big player in the energy field with various projects across the United States and internationally.

MICHAEL MCLARNEY

For 25 years, Michael McLarney's way has been the United Way. Since 1989 McLarney has served as president of United Way of the Midlands, an organization he joined before earning a UNO bachelor's degree in general studies in 1975. He has served United Way in a variety of capacities, overseeing its campaign, its finances and administration, its marketing, and its communications.

McLarney also maintains an active and visible role in various organizations affecting the welfare of thousands of Omahans. He volunteers his time on numerous boards, committees and coalitions, including Omaha 2000, Safe Futures, Youth Leadership Omaha and the Domestic Violence Coordinating Council. In 1993, McLarney received the 1993 Outstanding Citizen Award from Woodmen of the World Alpha Lodge.

CAROL SCHRADER

Carol Schrader earned a bachelor's degree in journalism in 1988 after returning to UNO and finishing the work she began in the early 1970s when she was a Homecoming Queen, *Gateway* editor and Student Senate treasurer.

She began her broadcasting career as an intern with a TV station and continued as a reporter with an all-news radio station. In 1977 she joined Omaha's KETV Channel 7 as a reporter and soon became an anchor. One of the things Omahans remember her best for is her "Wednesday's Child" program that focused on children with special needs who were up for adoption.

In 1997 Schrader changed fields and joined KFAB Radio as the station's news director and cohost of its highly rated "Good Morning" show.
