ACADEMIC REGALIA

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries. The hoods are a carry-over from the times when monks, who operated these universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe is an adaptation of the shoulder cape also worn by these same monks while collecting alms.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of University officials adopted a universal code of design and color for the academic garb. This code has undergone several revisions in subsequent years.

Styling of the robes varies for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees with the width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increasing with each advanced degree. Hoods are normally not used for bachelor's degrees today. Instead, the tassel colors are used to indicate the degree program. All doctoral degree recipients are indicated by a gold tassel.

UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM

The University Honors Program is a University-wide program providing maximum educational opportunities for students of high ability through special multidisciplinary seminars and participation in an academic level not generally possible in usual curricular offerings.

The program is an outgrowth of the Arts and Sciences Honors program and was initiated in 1978. It is governed through the office of the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and administered through the Honors Coordinator. UNO colleges which implement Honors Programs include Arts and Sciences; Business Administration; Education; Public Affairs and Community Service; Information Science and Technology; and Communication, Fine Arts and Media.

As part of their Honors Program requirements, students undertake a research project that results in a Senior Honors Thesis. Students and their majors are listed at the end of the list of graduates. Students who have been designated in this booklet as Honors Program students have fulfilled the academic requirements of this program. Honors Program graduates wear blue and scarlet Honors cords.

STUDENT COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

JANEY E. STROBEL

Janey Strobel, an Omaha native, graduates summa cum laude today with a bachelor of arts degree in English. Her commencement address is titled "What We Take."

On campus, she was active with Sigma Tau Delta, Phi Kappa Phi and the Honors Program. As an honors student, Strobel completed a creative project featuring a collection of poetry titled "People in Poetry: Nebraska Portraits." Her work was then submitted to literary journals, resulting in the publication of two poems.

Strobel is the recipient of a Regents Scholarship and the Helen B. Anderson Scholarship, and was regularly named to the Dean's and Chancellor's Lists. She also won the Outstanding Student in American Literature Award and earned a prize for the best informative speech in the semiannual Informative Speech Competition.

An interest in visual and written arts - especially painting, drawing and poetry - led to the recent completion of her first oil painting. Strobel also enjoys scrapbooking and greeting card/interior design.

Graduation is a family affair for Strobel, as her brother also receives a degree during today's ceremony. After graduation, she plans to attend graduate school next fall and hopes to earn a master of fine arts in poetry and teach creative writing at the collegiate level. She and her fiance are also planning a wedding for next summer.

ALUMNUS ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENT

JOHN JETER

For more than half a century, John Jeter has compiled an extensive record of dedication and service to the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO). He earned a bachelor of science degree in accounting from UNO in 1954.

A 1949 Omaha Benson High School graduate, Jeter spent two years in the U.S. Air Force before enrolling at Omaha University and playing football as a freshman. He became a member and officer of Sigma Phi Epsilon and Omicron Delta Kappa, and was a member of Beta Alpha Psi.

At UNO, he was a staff officer in the university's Air Force ROTC program and, as a senior, was named Distinguished Military Student for outstanding military and academic achievement. He became the university's first student to receive the Omaha Education Committee of National Association of Manufacturers Scholarship and was president of the Corinthians, an honorary scholarship society.

After graduation, he joined Arthur Anderson and Co., becoming a partner in the firm in 1967, and was assigned to the Omaha, Dallas and Denver offices. For many years, Jeter was in charge of the Omaha audit practice and had regional utility responsibilities during his assignments in each office.

Jeter has testified as an expert in accounting and utility regulation before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, the Interstate Commerce Commission and 16 state regulatory agencies. He also testified before the National Energy Board of Canada; the Alberta, Canada, utility regulatory agency; and the County and Federal District Courts in three states.

He retired from Arthur Andersen in 1991, after more than 37 years with the firm. Since retirement, he has continued to consult with and supply testimony on behalf of utilities and telecommunications companies. In 1994, Jeter was elected to the Tucson Electric Power Company's board of directors. He served on the board of UniSource Energy Corporation, Tucson Electric Company's parent company, from 1998 until his retirement in 2001.

Jeter's alumni service began in 1962, when he became a member of the Alumni Association's board of directors, to which he served six years as treasurer and a year as president. In 1974, he was presented with one of the association's inaugural Outstanding Service Awards that honors faculty, staff, alumni or friends who have shown continuous, outstanding service to the association and/or university. In 1988, he received the inaugural UNO College of Business Administration Alumni Achievement Award.

Instrumental to the 2006 expansion and renovation of the Alumni Association's William H. and Dorothy Thompson Alumni Center, Jeter spearheaded funding for a new event space, the Arthur Andersen Hospitality Room. In 2007, Andersen served as treasurer of the association's newly founded Detachment 470 Air Force ROTC Alumni Chapter.

Jeter has served on the boards and been an officer of community organizations such as the Visiting Nurses Association, the Douglas County Historical Society and similar organizations in Dallas and Denver. He currently assists the Douglas County Historical Society and the Ford Conservation Center with financial matters.

He and his wife, Phyllis, are trustees of the University of Nebraska Foundation and members of the University of Nebraska President's Club. Jeter also is a member of the foundation's administrative committee and served on the UNO College of Business Administration's National Advisory Board.
