What is Sweatshop labor?



A "sweatshop" is defined by the US Department of Labor as a factory that violates 2 or more labor laws. Sweatshops often have poor working conditions, unfair wages, unreasonable hours, child labor, and a lack of benefits for workers.

Companies: Nike audits: From 2001 to 2005, the paperwork audit showed that working conditions were steadily improving. When inspectors checked the qualitative audit, though, they found that nearly 80 percent of them either hadn't improved—or had gotten worse


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
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Western companies send in order, under a "fast fashion" model



Factory managers, stressed for time, push their workers into overtime, causing sleep deprivation and accidents

If they can't make the deadline, they subcontract out the work

The factories that are subcontracted to are unregistered and unsupervised. This is where the worst abuses take place.

Furthermore, in places like New Delhi, about 80% of garment work is informal (homes, workshops, backyards)





How much are you willing to spend for a good quality long-sleeve t-shirt?






Do you know what fair-t
